but it was a good touring car load at least. No one was living in the house.

**Steal Clothing**  
Sunday night thieves broke into the home of William T. Woodley, S. Sheridan road, while no one was at home, and took numerous articles of clothing. They didn't take advantage of the opportunity to take jewelry and silverware. The robbery was reported to the police, and a rigorous search for the thieves was instituted. Every train and street car passing through Highland Park was searched, and automobiles were searched at Lake Forest and Winnetka. The local police covered the territory west of the city. But no trace of the robbers was found. The police are exerting themselves to the utmost to prevent further robberies, and to catch the thieves who have been operating here. But they are working under difficulties. The force is provided with only two men for the night shift. Winnetka has nine men. And having to cover the territory from Highwood to the Cook county line, they cannot patrol it very effectively.

As far as the robbers are concerned they will be shown no mercy. The police will take no chances, and are determined to shoot first, and ask questions later. They ask more cooperation on the part of the public. Any disturbance should be reported immediately, and as quietly as possible. Also, people leaving their homes vacant for the winter should notify the police station.
