

## **NAVAL STATION MAKES** \$506,850 LAND AWARDS

MANY ACRES INVOLVED

Commandant Wurtzbaugh Notifies All Owners: They May Take or Leave These Offers

Commandant Wurtzbaugh of Great Lakes station made public the awards made by the navy department on all property taken by the department during the war and on which the camps west of the railroad tracks

In all, the awards totaled \$506,850. In making the awards public the commandant stated that the navy department did not wish to return any of the property on which improvements had been made, but plainly stated that it would be agreeable for the property owners to take back those tracts on which nothing had been done. 
