**SOLDIER PATIENTS ARE BEING REMOVED**

**Transfer 21 Men From Sunnybrook Farm to Government Hospitals**

That an institution in western Lake County which has been treating service men whose minds were affected by gas, etc., has not been treating them properly but that they have been neglected whereas they are the ones which should be handled with all tenderness possible, is evident from this item from a Chicago paper:  
 "As the result of an investigation into conditions at Sunnybrook Farm, near Long Lake, Ill., made by State Commander McCauley, twenty-one ex-service men; receiving treatment for mental diseases will be transferred to government hospitals before the end of the week.  
 "The order transferring the men was issued by government officials in less than twelve hours after the report was submitted."  
 Lake County people generally did not know that such a number of mental victims from the war had been under courses of treatment at the Sunnybrook farm, in fact many who have driven past the place often this summer did not realize there were working or lolling about the place were heroes of the great war.

**NAVAL STATION MAKES \$506,850 LAND AWARDS**

**MANY ACRES INVOLVED**

**Commandant Wurtzbaugh Notifies All Owners: They May Take or Leave These Offers**

Commandant Wurtzbaugh of Great Lakes station made public the awards made by the navy department on all property taken by the department during the war and on which the camps west of the railroad tracks were erected.  
 In all, the awards totaled \$506,850.  
 In making the awards public the commandant stated that the navy department did not wish to return any of the property on which improvements had been made, but plainly stated that it would be agreeable for the property owners to take back those tracts on which nothing had been done. In the latter was the Dewey residence and tract, standing on Green Bay Road, that big brick place on the east side of the road.  
 Captain Wurtzbaugh explained that there is now being prepared a bill by a committee of congress to make available funds to pay the awards as announced now; that the money will be used to pay them; that a bill will also be introduced which will provide for the return of the property to those who are not satisfied with the award. The formal return of their property, must be made through a special bill. This bill must provide for the return of the property and the payment of actual damages incurred by the work the navy department did upon it and what it will be required to do to put it back in the same shape as before the government took it over.
