CHILDREN'S HOME AT LAKE BLUFF PLANNED

333 Acre Busse Farm May Be Site of Salvation Army Institution For Illinois

The Salvation Army has taken ar option on the 333 acre Busse farm at Fox take and plans to operate there in the near future, providing the sale goes through, a children's home—a where boys and girls can be cared for, taught farming, and house

There are six similar farms in the United States operated by the Sal-Army and the one in Lake County is expected to take care of all children in Illinois who might come under the care of the Salvation

The Salvation Army in these homes promotes all kinds of educational ideas for boys and girls. They teach the boys farming and various trades and teach the girls domestic science and housekeeping.

They endeavor all along to keep away from the name reformatory and therefore these farms are in no way classed as reformatory schools.

The property in question is of sufficient size to accommodate about 200 children. Wherever the Salvation Army has established homes of this sort they have equipped the property in fine shape. In the Busse property according to officers of the organization they have a place that is unusually well fitted for their purposes.


