**CHILDREN'S HOME AT
LAKE BLUFF PLANNED**

TAKE OPTION ON LAND

333 Acre Busse Farm May
Be Site of Salvation
Army Institution
For Illinois

The Salvation Army has taken an option on the 333 acre Busse farm at Fox Lake and plans to operate there in the near future, providing the sale goes through, a children's home—a place where boys and girls can be cared for, taught farming, and house-keeping.

There are six similar farms in the United States operated by the Salvation Army and the one in Lake County is expected to take care of all the children in Illinois who might come under the care of the Salvation Army.

The Salvation Army in these homes promotes all kinds of educational ideas for boys and girls. They teach the boys farming and various trades and teach the girls domestic science and housekeeping.

They endeavor all along to keep away from the name reformatory and therefore these farms are in no way classed as reformatory schools.

The property in question is of sufficient size to accommodate about 200 children. Wherever the Salvation Army has established homes of this sort they have equipped the property in fire shape. In the Busse property according to officers of the organization they have a place that is unusually well fitted for their purposes.

The Busse farm lies on the east side of the road running north and south.

Capt. Rhoda of the Salvation Army at Waukegan conferred with the finance committee of the supervisors last week and asked the committee to recommend \$15,000 toward the work. The committee explained that they did not have the money to do that and under the law would have no right to do it anyway. They added, however, that they would recommend that delinquent children of the county be diverted to the farm for

keep and that the county could and would pay for their expenses.

**\$42,000,000 PAID
IN THIS DISTRICT**

On June 15th \$42,000,000 was paid to holders of the First Liberty Bonds and Victory Notes in the Seventh Federal Reserve District. This is the semi-annual interest due on the two issues, of which \$1,129,242,500 worth was subscribed for in this district.
