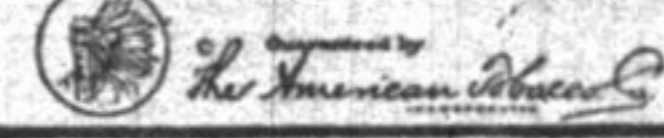

UTILITIES NOW RURAL FIXTURE

Washington, D. C. — Preliminary figures of the 1920 census of agriculture show telephones reported on 2,508,002 farms, or 38.9 per cent of all farms in the United States in 1920. More than one-half of the farms in the following states reported telephones: Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Nebraska, Indiana, Missouri, Ohio, Minnesota, South Dakota, Wisconsin, Vermont, Connecticut, Massachusetts and Oregon.

The states reporting the largest number of telephones in 1920 were as follows: Iowa, 183,852; Illinois, 173,647; Missouri, 163,543; Ohio, 159,478; Texas, 140,234; and Indiana, 136,140.

Gas or electric light was reported on 452,800 farms, 7 per cent of all farms in the United States. In seven states more than 20,000 farms were reported as having gas or electric light, as follows: Ohio, 37,745; Iowa, 32,552; Pennsylvania, 30,669; California, 30,519; New York, 24,882; Illinois, 23,273; and Indiana, 20,584.
