### ELECTRIC ROAD TO CHANGE ITS ROUTE

C. N. S. & M. Plans to Build New Tracks Through Evanston and Wilmette

The North Shore Connecting Railroad Co. applied last week to the Illinois Commerce Commission for permission to construct an electric railway line through certain parts of Evanston and Wilmette.

This means that steps have been taken toward changing the route of the Chicago, North Shore and Milwaukee electric line through Evanston. The name "Connecting Railroad Co." is that applied to the company organized to construct the new stretch of track.

The move to change the route of the North Shore electric line through Evanston has been expected for some time. The North Shore line has been refused an extension of its charter to operate over the streets of Wilmette, which necessitates the buying of a private right of way by the electric line in that village. With the line thus entering Evanston at a different point the company wishes to continue the line through Evanston at that point on its own right-of-way.

L. H. W. Speidel and wife to Giuseppe Patricelli and wife, W. part Later, a firm of organ makers in Germany succeeded in erecting the first really big instrument. The primary stops did not differ very much from those of to-day, although various novelties were introduced.

Among the innovations were the nightingale and cuckoo stops, while others representing cock-crowing and goat-bleating. Though these novelties have now fallen into disuse, an organ with one of these nightingale stops is still to be seen in Rome.

It was not until the nineteenth century that the problem of the regulation of air pressures was solved by the introduction of the hydraulic blower.

Amongst the largest organs in the world are the Harlem, Holland, instrument, which possesses sixty stops and 8,000 pipes; the Albert Hall, London. Organ, with 125 stops; the organ in St. George's hall, Liverpool, with 110 stops; one at St. Louis, Australia, which boasts 150 stops; and one in Sydney, Australia, Town Hall with 125 stops.
