

Make Noisy Lines The cloth-covered cord which connects your telephone instrument with the bell box and the cord running to the telephone receiver are each made up of a number of fine wires covered with light insulation. If these cords were not made in this way they would not be flexible. They are necessarily delicate

and easily put out of order by misuse. Subscribers are requested to avoid twisting and knotting the telephone cords as this wears through the insulation, breaks the fine wires and causes short circuits. The first effect is usually a scratching noise in the receiver and later the telephone is put out of
