\$113,685 RECEIVED FOR SCHOOL BONDS
 At a special meeting of the Board of Education for District 107 held at a recent date at the Elm Place building, bids for the issue of school bonds to the amount of \$110,000 were received. These bonds are to bear interest at the rate of 5 per cent per annum, payable semi-annually and to bear date the first day of April, 1922. They are to become due as follows:
 \$1000 in 1924
 \$2000 each in 1925 and 1926
 \$5000 each in the years 1927 to 1931 inclusive.
 \$8000 each in the years 1932 to 1941 inclusive.
 The present bonding capacity of the district is \$135,000. There were still outstanding bonds to the extent of \$23,000 and these with this new issue of \$110,000 practically exhausted the bonding capacity of the district.
 Seven bond houses were represented at the sale of the new issue and there was a marked variation in the premium offered by the different houses. The highest bidder was the First Trust and Savings Bank of Chicago which offered a premium of \$3685. This bid was accepted by the Board of Education and the issue of \$110,000 in bonds sold to them for \$113,685.
