Notice is hereby given to all persons interested that the Council of the City of Highland Park, County of Lake, and State of Illinois, having ordered that Dean Avenue be extended and opened from the south line of Roger Williams Avenue to a line one-hundred thirty-six (136) feet easterly from and parallel with the easterly line of the right of way of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Company; also that Dean Avenue as so extended and opened be paved with an asphaltic macadam wearing surface on a Portland Cement Concrete base twenty (20) feet in width and otherwise improved, the ordinance for the same being on file in the office of the City Clerk of said city and having applied to the County Court of Lake County for an assessment of the costs of said improvement according to benefits, and an assessment thereof having been made and returned to said court, the final hearing thereon will be had on the 7th day of July, A. D. 1922, or as soon thereafter as the business of the court will permit.

Said assessment is payable in five installments, with interest at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum on all installments from and after date of issue of first voucher. All persons desiring may file objections in said court before said day and may appear on the hearing and make their defense.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OR STANDING OF VEHICLES IN PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That no automobile, truck, or motor-driven vehicle of any kind or description, and no wagon, sleigh, sled, carriage, or any horse-drawn vehicle of any kind or description, shall be permitted to be parked or to remain or stand in GREEN BAY ROAD or any part thereof; in ST. JOHN'S AVENUE between Central Avenue and Vine Avenue, or any part thereof; in CENTRAL AVENUE west of Green Bay Road, or any part thereof; in SHERIDAN ROAD from its intersection with Dean Avenue and Cedar Avenue to the County Line Road, or any part thereof; in SECOND STREET from its intersection with Green Bay Road to Central Avenue, or any part thereof; in ROGER WILLIAMS AVENUE east of Sheridan Road, or any part thereof; in CEDAR AVENUE east of Sheridan Road, or any part thereof; in BEECH STREET east of Sheridan Road, or any part thereof; in HAZEL AVENUE east of its intersection with Lake Avenue, or any part thereof; in PROSPECT AVENUE east of Lake Avenue, or any part thereof; in LAUREL AVENUE, East of LAKE AVENUE, or any part thereof; in CENTRAL AVENUE east of Dale Avenue, or any part thereof; in RAVINE PLACE south of Vine Avenue, or any part thereof; in VINE AVENUE east of Ravine Place, or any part thereof; in SHERIDAN ROAD north of Broadway, or any part thereof; all in the city of Highland Park, except for the purpose of loading or unloading.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in a sum not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each violation.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
