APPROPRIATION TO STAY AT \$200,000.

Great Lakes Naval Training Station Must Get Along on Small Amount

Dispatches from Washington tell of the defeat of the movement to increase the naval station appropriation to \$350,000.

On the other hand the plan to authorize the establishment of a naval reserve similar to the national guard has been voted.

The dispatch follows: Washington, D. C.—The navy department plan to create a civilian naval reserve force similar to the national guard has been adopted by the Senate.

Under the plan of the department 3,000 officers and 10,000 enlisted men would be molded into a civilian reserve force paid for one month's service annually.

A motion of Senator McCormick, Republican (Ill.) to increase the funds for the Great Lakes naval training station from \$200,000 voted by the House to \$350,000 was rejected.

\$3,000,000 HOSPITAL FOR GREAT LAKES

War Veterans' Bureau Institution to be Erected Soon at Naval Station

A new hospital for disabled soldiers, to cost \$3,000,000 and designed to accommodate 1,000 patients, is to be built on a site adjoining the Great Lakes naval training station hospital.

The erection of this hospital is in line with recently announced plans for building twelve similar institutions in the country.

The committee of the Veteran's Bureau came to Great Lakes from Washington recently and made a thorough inspection of the six hundred acre tract west of the North Western railroad tracts at the station.

The committee upon its return to Washington made a favorable report and President Harding has just signed a document authorizing the transfer of this large tract from the navy department to the War Veterans' Bureau.

The authorities of Great Lakes do not anticipate any changes in the present hospital at the station which has a capacity for accommodating several hundred men.
