GREATER INTEREST IN RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Development Has Been Very Rapid Summer Students Are Told

Widespread and increasing interest in religious education, with lively co-operation by public school officials and people of various communities, was reported last Friday afternoon by Prof. John E. Stout, of the religious education department of Northwestern university. Prof. Stout addressed summer students of the university in Harris hall and his topic was "Recent Developments in Religious Education."

Referring to the number of communities, small cities and towns, whose people are taking individual interest in seeing that children are receiving more intelligent religious training, Prof. Stout declared that the task of directing the work is being successfully met by teachers.

"Week-day and vacation schools and community training schools are being maintained," he said. "These do not displace or make less necessary the efforts of individual churches to maintain their Sunday schools but, on the contrary, they make such efforts more fruitful. They make all undertakings of individual churches to care for the religious life of children and youth more fruitful. They elevate religious education to a plane of efficiency, provide instruction in the great common values of religion, and, in fact, make religious instruction an integral part of all education. Every community in America needs to have this service performed. In many communities it is now being performed successfully."

"The church is not alone in its awakening to the need of a more adequate program of religious education. The public school is also becoming conscious of this need. This institution cannot provide the program, but it can co-operate with the church in such a way as to make the program possible. It is already doing this."

"Conscious of the primacy of religion in life, school officials and teachers are willing to give substantial recognition to the work done by these schools. Credit is being allowed by substituting one or more units of work, or time is being granted out of the public school program to permit children to attend the week-end schools. The church and the school are thus co-operating in the education of children and youth."

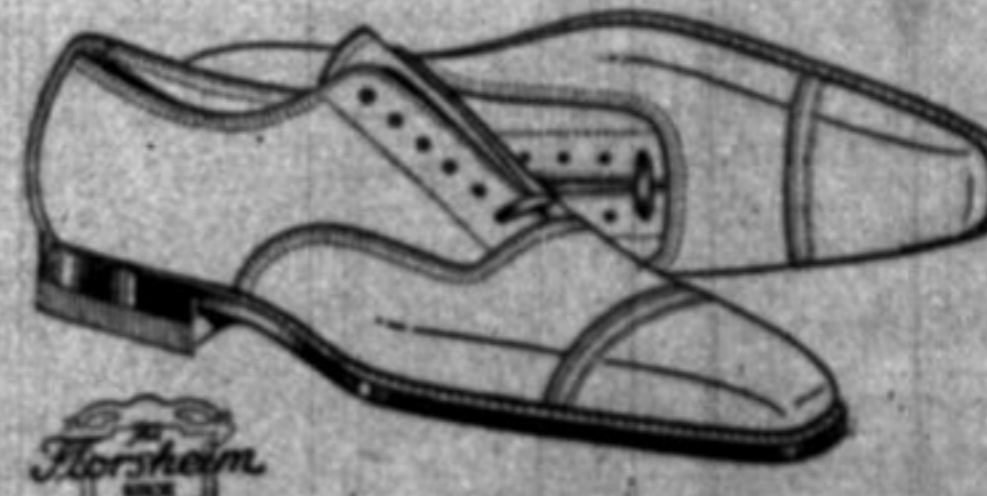
