### LAKE COUNTY LEADS IN LAW ENFORCEMENT

#### Strong Prosecutors of Booze Violators; Fines Pay More Than Expenses

Prohibition enforcement in Lake county has been more aggressive and has brought more definite results than in any other county in Illinois, according to official figures just given out in Springfield. Not only does Lake county lead the other counties in the state in the number of prosecutions, but also in the number of convictions, amount of fines collected and money turned over to the county after all expenses have been paid.

The following dispatch gives an idea of how Lake county leads the field, showing how its prosecutions have exceeded those in a majority of the counties:

Illinois was declared to have paid a net profit of about 300 per cent on the investment, in a report of compilations of the Anti-Saloon league made public here today by George Yule, district superintendent of the league. For every dollar expended by the counties for investigation and prosecutions more than \$3, Mr. Yule said, has come into the county coffers in fines and forfeitures.

The state law provides that fines and forfeitures shall be applied to paying the salaries of state's attorneys and their assistants, and if there is any of the fund so collected remaining after payment of these salaries it shall go into the county school distributable fund.

Money collected from prohibition prosecutions throughout the state, counties pay their state's attorneys' salaries, and in many counties substantial surplus sums have been turned over for the benefit of the schools.

Lake County

Lake county, with the collection of \$30,919 in fines, seems to have shown the greatest activity in prose-

violations. Of this number, 340 defendants were convicted. Forty-six prison terms were imposed and fines of \$63,350 were assessed. A little less than half the fines were collected, but at that the investment to Lake county has returned fully 100 per cent, for the prosecution and arrests cost the county only \$15,000, about half the sum of the fines collected.

Cook County Unlisted

Some of the other counties of the state from which records have been collected, showing the fines collected and the cost of the work, are as follows:

Bond county, \$2,500 collected, cost \$100; Clark, \$2,095 collected, cost \$300; Crawford, \$1,555 collected, cost \$75; Dekalb, \$7,900 collected, cost \$1,000; Ford, \$1,630 collected, cost \$400; Franklin, \$6,200 collected, cost \$1,250; Grundy, \$2,300 collected, cost, \$50; Knox, \$1,800 collected, cost \$494.80; Moran, \$1,200 collected, cost \$400; Woodford, \$750 collected without cost; Kankakee, \$9,000 collected, cost \$2,000; Logan, \$2,400 collected, cost \$586; Bond, \$4,000 collected, cost \$500; Randolph, \$7,000 collected, cost \$1,200; Montgomery, \$7,000 collected, cost \$1,200.

"It pays in actual money to enforce prohibition," said Mr. Yule. "Every county that has tried it has profited financially as well as innumerable other ways. The money from these fines and forfeitures goes to help pay the overhead expenses of the county and thus aids in reducing taxes."

This county, until a certain date, has made 433 arrests for liquor law violations, according to Mr. Yule's figures.
