CLEOPATRA'S HEAD, ANCIENT SCULPTURE

SEEN AT ART INSTITUTE

Other Notable Works of Similar Character Found Among Ruins Exhibited for First Time

Cleopatra for sale? Yes, at any rate her head, carved in Egyptian limestone and found in lower Egypt. While it is impossible at this date to verify the assertion that it is a true likeness of the famous queen, still the claim rests on a substantial foundation.

It is the work of a sculptor of the Ptolemaic period and is a meritorious piece of art. A student of character would instantly note the sweetness of expression about the finely carved lips. There is no cruelty there, and not even a strong indication of the sensuousness which historians charge against her. The head is narrow, much narrower, than we are wont to see in other Egyptian rulers. Thus the character student premises that she ruled through her intellect, which was singularly keen and intuitional rather than aggressive and forceful. The head-dress is adequately suggested though the sculptor left the back of the head in an unfinished state quite in the manner Rodin used centuries later.

One of Eleven Treasures

This notable piece of sculpture is one of eleven original pieces, mostly of marble, which were unearthed in various parts of Europe, Africa and Asia Minor, and which were brought to America by a New York importer. They are now on exhibition at the Art Institute in Room 250, and will be here only a few weeks longer. They are for sale and it will be a matter of great regret if they are not acquired by some friend and presented to the Art Institute. While this museum has many reproductions of Greek, Roman and Egyptian sculpture, it is sadly deficient in originals.

Besides the sculptured head of Cleopatra, there is one of the finest heads of Augustus Caesar in existence. It is of white marble of heroic size and was unearthed in Asia Minor. The sculptor is unknown but he has given to Caesar's face an expression of thoughtfulness and of kindly interest wholly lacking in other statues of this famous Roman emperor. You feel that you would like to know the man with such a face.
