Plats, page 101, described as follows: Beginning at a point 95 feet North of the North line of Cary Avenue Extended, measured along the East line of Sheridan Road, thence 80 feet North along said East side of Sheridan Road to North line of Lot 70, thence easterly along said North line of Lot 70, 40 feet, thence southwesterly 95 feet to a point of beginning. All in southeast 1/4, Section 25, Township 43 North, Range 12 East of the 3d P. M.

All that part of Lot 4 of Birch and Williams Partition of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 36, Township 43 North, Range 12, East of the 3d P. M., described as follows: Beginning at a point on the East line of Sheridan Road, 727 feet West of the East line of Section 36, Township 43 North, Range 12 East of the 3d P. M. and 417 feet North of the South line of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 36, thence Northeasterly in a straight line 60 feet, to a point thirty (30) feet east of a line 727 feet East of and parallel with the East line of said Section 36, thence Northwesterly in a straight line 100 feet to the aforesaid East line of Sheridan Road, thence Easterly along said Easterly line of Sheridan Road along a line 727 feet West of and parallel with the East line of said Section 36, 145 feet to the point of beginning, all in the City of Highland Park, County of Lake and State of Illinois. That in said proceedings for the purpose of making said improvement, and of determining what property will be benefited thereby and the amount of such benefit, the estimated total cost of such improvement as shown by the estimate being the sum of One Hundred Eighty Six Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Nine Dollars and no cents (\$186,889.00); Commissioners were duly appointed by the said Court to investigate and report the just compensation to be made for private property to be taken or damaged for said improvement and also what real estate will be benefited by such improvement and the amount of such benefits to each parcel of land benefited thereby, and that said Commissioners duly made a special assessment to raise the cost of such improvement and duly filed their report in the office of the Clerk of the said Court on the 20th day of October A. D. 1922, which report shows the total cost of said improvement to be the sum of One Hundred Eighty Six Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Nine Dollars (\$186,889.00).

Thereupon a summons issued out of said Court against the defendants above named, returnable at the County Court House in the City of Waukegan in said County on the 27th day of November A. D. 1922 as is by law required which proceeding is still pending. Now, unless you, the said defendants, shall be and appear before the said County Court of Lake County, Illinois, at the Court House in the City of Waukegan, in said County on or before the 27th day of November A. D. 1922, and plead, answer or demur to the petitioner's petition, or object to the report of the Commissioners aforesaid, the same and the matters therein charged and stated will be taken as confessed, and a judgment entered in accordance with the said report and the prayer of the said petition.

The following is a description of the lots, blocks, tracts or parcels of land to be taken or damaged for the proposed improvement aforesaid, viz:

All that part of the S. W. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 of Section 31, Fractional T. 43 North, Range 13 E. of the 3d P. M., described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the Northeast line of Sheridan Road with the North line of Lot 4 of Carolyn, a subdivision of part of S. W. 1/4, S. W. 1/4, Section 31, Fractional T. 43, N. Range 13, East, 3rd P. M., as recorded in Book "H" of Plats, page 57, thence North 32°-44' West along the Northeast line of Sheridan Road 33.3 feet to where said line turns North; thence North 2°-21' East on the East line of Sheridan Road 68.5 feet, thence Southerly along a curved line having a radius of 217 feet, convex Southwesterly, a distance of 97.3 feet to the said North line of Lot 4; thence South 48°-31' West along the North line of said Lot 4, 3.7 feet to the point of beginning.

Also, that part of Lot 4 of Carolyn, a subdivision of part of the S. W. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 of Section 31, Township 43 North, Range 13 East of the 3d P. M., as recorded in Book "H" of Plats, page 57, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the North line of Sheridan Road 33 feet North of the South line of Section 31, Fractional Township 43 North, Range 13 East of the 3d P. M. and 109.3 feet East of the Southwest corner of said Lot 4; thence West along the North line of Sheridan Road 91.2 feet to where said line turns Northwesterly; thence North 32°-44' West along the Northeast line of Sheridan Road 91.2 feet; thence Southerly along a curved line having a radius of 167 feet, convex Southwesterly a distance of 167 feet to the point of beginning.

Also, that part of the North half of the N. W. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 of Section 31, Fractional Township 43 North, Range 13 East of the 3d P. M., described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the west line of Sheridan Road with the South line

of North 1/2, N. W. 1/4, S. W. 1/4, Section 31, Fractional T. 43 North, Range 13 East of the 3d P. M., thence North 8°-45' East on the Westerly line of Sheridan Road as now laid out 216.5 feet; thence North 48°-02' West 43.7 feet; thence South 0°-05' West 243.2 feet to the point of beginning, the last course being the West line of Sheridan Road South of the point of beginning extended Northwesterly.

Also, that part of the North 1/2 of the N. W. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 of Section 31, Fractional Township 43 North, Range 13, East of the 3d P. M., described as follows: Beginning at a point on the Westerly line of Sheridan Road as now laid out 216.5 feet North of the intersection of said line with the South line of North 1/2, Northwest 1/4, Southwest 1/4, Section 31, Fractional T. 43 North, Range 13, East of the 3d P. M., thence North 8°-45' East along said Westerly line of Sheridan Road 45.4 feet to where said line turns Northwesterly; thence North 109°-40' West along the Westerly line of Sheridan Road as now laid out 378.8 feet to a point 33 feet South of the North line of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 31; thence West along a line 33 feet South of the said North line of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 31, 142.1 feet; thence Southeasterly along a curved line having a radius of 167 feet, convex Northeasterly, a distance of 270.3 feet; thence South 0°-05' West, 214.5 feet, this course being the West line of Sheridan Road as located in the South 1/2, Northwest 1/4, Southwest 1/4, of said Section 31, extended Northwesterly; thence South 48°-02' East 43.7 feet to the point of beginning.

Also, that part of Lot 4, of Birch and Williams Partition of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 36, Township 43 North, Range 12, East of the 3d P. M., described as follows: Beginning at a point 33 feet North of the South line of the Northeast 1/4, Section 36, Township 43 North, Range 12, East of the 3d P. M., and 727 feet West of the East line of said Section 36, being the point where the North and East lines of Sheridan Road intersect; thence North along the East line of Sheridan Road 81 feet; thence Southeasterly along a curved line having a radius of 81.0 feet, convex Southwesterly, a distance of 127.3 feet to a point on the North line of Sheridan Road; thence West along the North line of Sheridan Road; 81 feet to the point of beginning.

Also, that part of Lot 4, of Birch and Williams Partition of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 36, Township 43 North, Range 12, East of the 3d P. M., described as follows: Beginning at a point on the East line of Sheridan Road 727 feet West of the East line of Section 36, Township 43 North, Range 12, East of the 3d P. M., and 235 feet North of the South line of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 36, being the point where the existing East line of Sheridan Road begins to curve Westerly; thence North on a line parallel to the East line of said Section 36, 450 feet to the point where the existing East line of Sheridan Road again joins the line parallel to and 727 feet West of the East line of said Section 36; thence southerly, curving Southwesterly, and thence Southeasterly along the existing East line of Sheridan Road 460 feet to the place of beginning.

M., and part of Section 31, Fractional Township 43 North, Range 13 East of the 3d P. M.

Beginning at the intersection of the North line of Lot 4, Carolyn Subdivision of part of Southwest 1/4, Southwest 1/4, Section 31, Fractional Township 43 North, Range 13, East of the 3d P. M., with the Northeast line of Sheridan Road as relocated, thence Southeast along said line of Sheridan Road 40 feet, thence North 32° East 30 feet, thence North 2°-21' East 20 feet, thence North 59° West 15 feet more or less to said North line of Lot 4, Carolyn Subdivision, thence South 48°-31' West on said North line of said Lot 4, 29 feet more or less to the point of beginning. Also: Beginning at said point of intersection of the North line of said Lot 4 and the Northeast line of Sheridan Road as relocated, thence Northwesterly on said line of Sheridan Road 40 feet, thence South 59° East 41 feet more or less to said North line of said Lot 4, thence South 48°-31' West on said North line of Lot 4, 29 feet more or less to the point of beginning.
