 per cent lower than the "person-to-person"
 rate, applies. You can then talk to all the
 members of your family, one after another,
 on the one call, if you wish.

Evening rates on "station-to-station" calls, which
 are about one-half the day rates, become effective
 at 8:30 p.m. After midnight the night rate, about
 one-fourth the day rate, applies.
