During the war the government offered war savings stamps, paying about four per cent as a method of saving for people of small means. Since the war, and to take the place of war savings certificates in denominations of \$25, \$100, and \$1,000, now sold to investors at \$20.50, \$82 and \$820, respectively.

They pay four per cent if held until maturity, five years from the date of issue. About \$625,000,000 of War Savings Stamps, series of 1918, become due January 1, 1923, and the government now offers to issue treasury savings certificates in exchange for them, affording to owners an opportunity to continue a safe invest-
