

More than 150 patients were cared for at the Victory Memorial hospital during the month of December, according to the reports presented at the monthly meeting last night at the nurses home.

Of this number 82 were dismissed from the hospital cured, 10 were discharged with signs of improvement, two left without showing improvement, nine died, six of that number institution deaths, meaning that they died after being in the hospital more than 48 hours.

The number of days of service rendered was 1183, and the Needlework Guild of America contributed 91 articles to patients in the hospital.


