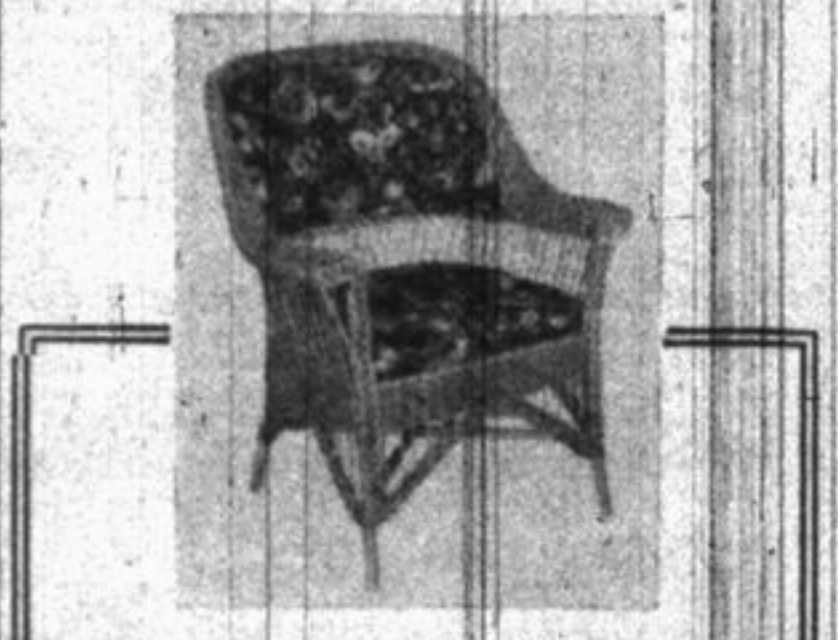

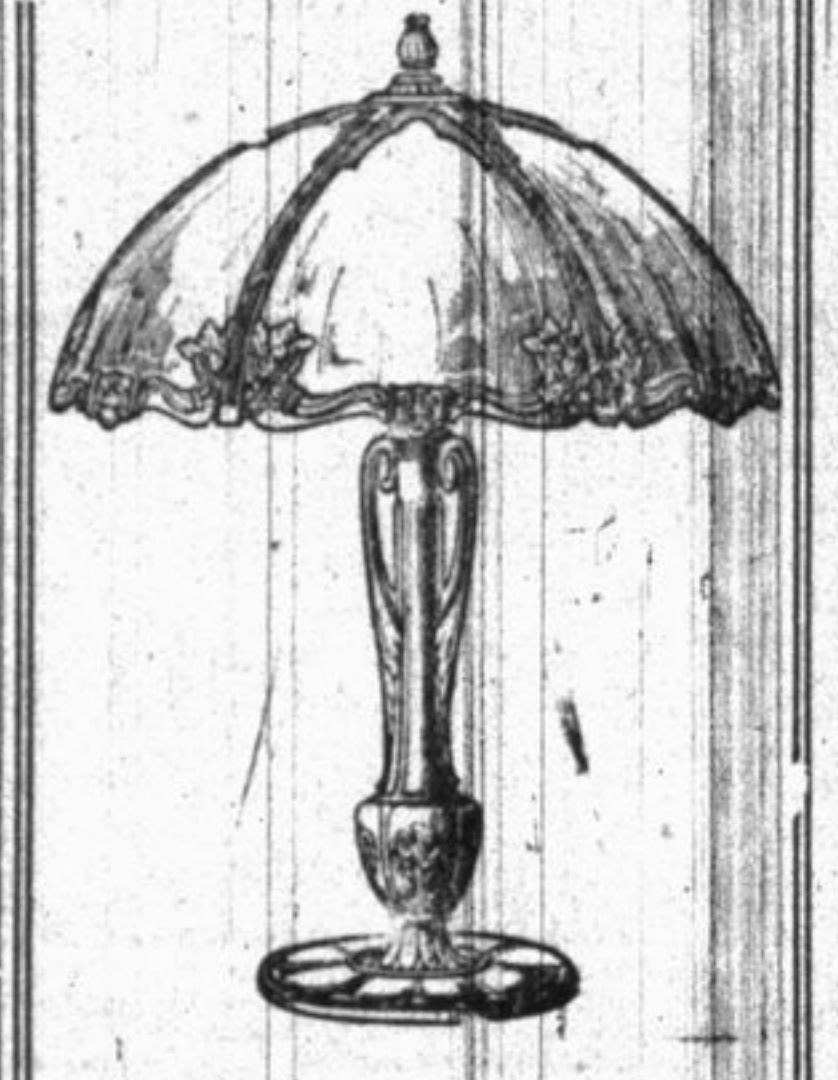
**U. S. CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATIONS.**

**LAGRANGE SCHOOL AUDITORIUM PLAN**  
 Elm Place School Boosters Point to Public Spiritedness of LaGrange People

At La Grange, Illinois, where they are putting up some elementary school building, the Board of Education has had difficulties somewhat like those confronting the Board of Education for District 107, Highland Park. The La Grange Board has funds sufficient to build the auditorium but not to equip it. Like the proposed Elm Place Auditorium, that at La Grange was to be for community

as well as school use. The equipment problem at La Grange has been solved by a public-spirited citizen, Mr. William Lydston, who has given thirty thousand dollars for that purpose. This will pay for a pipe organ, for opera chairs, stage fittings, motion picture equipment, and so forth. The gift is a memorial to the donor's father and the assembly room will be known as Lydston Memorial Hall. Another La Grange citizen, Mrs. George M. Vial, has agreed to pay for the equipment of a commodious library in the building. This will be known as the Vial Public Library and will be a memorial to the late George M. Vial. The gift will amount to four or five thousand.
