

PLANNING WOMAN'S CAMPUS AT N. W. U.

WITH GROUP BUILDINGS

Large Number of Coeds at This University Makes Move an Essential One, Belief of Promoters

An attractive campus, all their own; a group of buildings, spacious, adequate, and as lovely as the dreams of modern architecture can make them; a fully-equipped, special gymnasium, which will be the nucleus for a splendid school of physical training—these are some of the improvements that the women of Northwestern University are to have in the near future, and for which students and alumnae recently announced the opening of a campaign.

Not New Idea

This is no novel project, as successive committees of women from the University Guild, as well as many undergraduate agencies, have been and now are effectively working toward this end. With the completion of the fine group of men's dormitories on the upper Evanston campus in 1914, the next step contemplated was the achievement of accommodations of equal dignity and adequacy for the women of the university. Unhappily, the world war intervened and put a temporary check on all such plans.

But now, with Northwestern again striding onward, with the development under way on the nine-acre Alexander McKinlock Memorial campus for the university's professional school in Chicago, it is proposed to house Northwestern women with a degree of comfort and dignity more consistent with academic ideals and in no way lower than that established for the men.

1,500 Women Students

"There are thin year on the campus at Evanston," declared Mrs. Carl R. Latham, trustee, today, "approximately 1500 women students. Only 296 of that number can be housed in existing dormitories. Something over 500 live in their own homes, thus leaving 604 for the boarding houses approved by the university."

CAMP ROOSEVELT TRAINING PLANS

TRAINING IN THE SCHOOL

Preliminary Work Being Done In Chicago Educational Institutions; Outlook Is Promising

Training to become cadet officers in the Chicago high schools, and to qualify as officers at Camp Roosevelt for the coming summer, has been started. About 125 Reserve Officers Training Corps students are enrolled in the class, which is being conducted at Lane Technical high school, Division and Sedgwick streets, by officers and non-commissioned officers of the U. S. Army who are now on duty in the Chicago schools. Classes are held on Saturday mornings, and will be conducted for a series of twelve weeks.

Class Instruction

This class instruction is being tried out for the first time in the history of the R. O. T. C. Hitherto boys were trained in their schools, and appointed cadet officers without any preliminary specialized training, upon proof of their fitness for such command. This "Intensive Training" will, however, insure a perfect camp organization upon the opening date, July 2.

Major F. L. Beals, U. S. A., Professor of Military Science and Tactics in the Chicago high schools, is directing the course, which is equally divided between theoretical and practical instruction, and will be conducted for a series of twelve weeks. It will cover camp customs and traditions, regulations, administration, infantry drill regulations, recruiting, military police, camp sanitation, military courtesy, scouting and patrolling, tactics and map reading.

Increased Interest

The interest evidenced by the students is greater than ever before, and it is anticipated that the summer of 1923 will be the most largely attended of any summer thus far.

The camp is located on Silver Lake, near Rolling Prairie, Ind., and while it was established primarily for Chicago boys, it accepts them from all parts of the country. Three divisions are included: Summer schools (including 7th and 8th grades and all high school courses), R. O. T. C. or military division for older boys, and Junior Camp.


