"Coke" Harris and Nafey Larson are fighting it out for first base. Harris is more experienced, but Nafey is a surer hitter.

For the other infield positions there is a flock of freshmen, Rosenthal, Kress, Davis and Conrad; Dever, Carlson, Olson and Roeber are also trying hard for an infield berth.

In the outfield Coach Williams has a good group of fly-chasers in Cameron, Laegeler, Gentiline, Beneventi, Lindenmeyer and Davidson.

As yet no captain has been chosen but Arthur Werhane has been appointed manager for this year.

Reay, informed those present regarding the building improvements at the club house, the large extension to the dining room, the new dining porch and the modern kitchen facilities installed, remarked upon the condition in which the greens and fairways came through the winter. Mr. Leith is now ready to give instruction to members, it was reported.

Improvements at Club

Probably people would realize that walking is a splendid sorine tonic if they had to pay for the privilege of doing it.



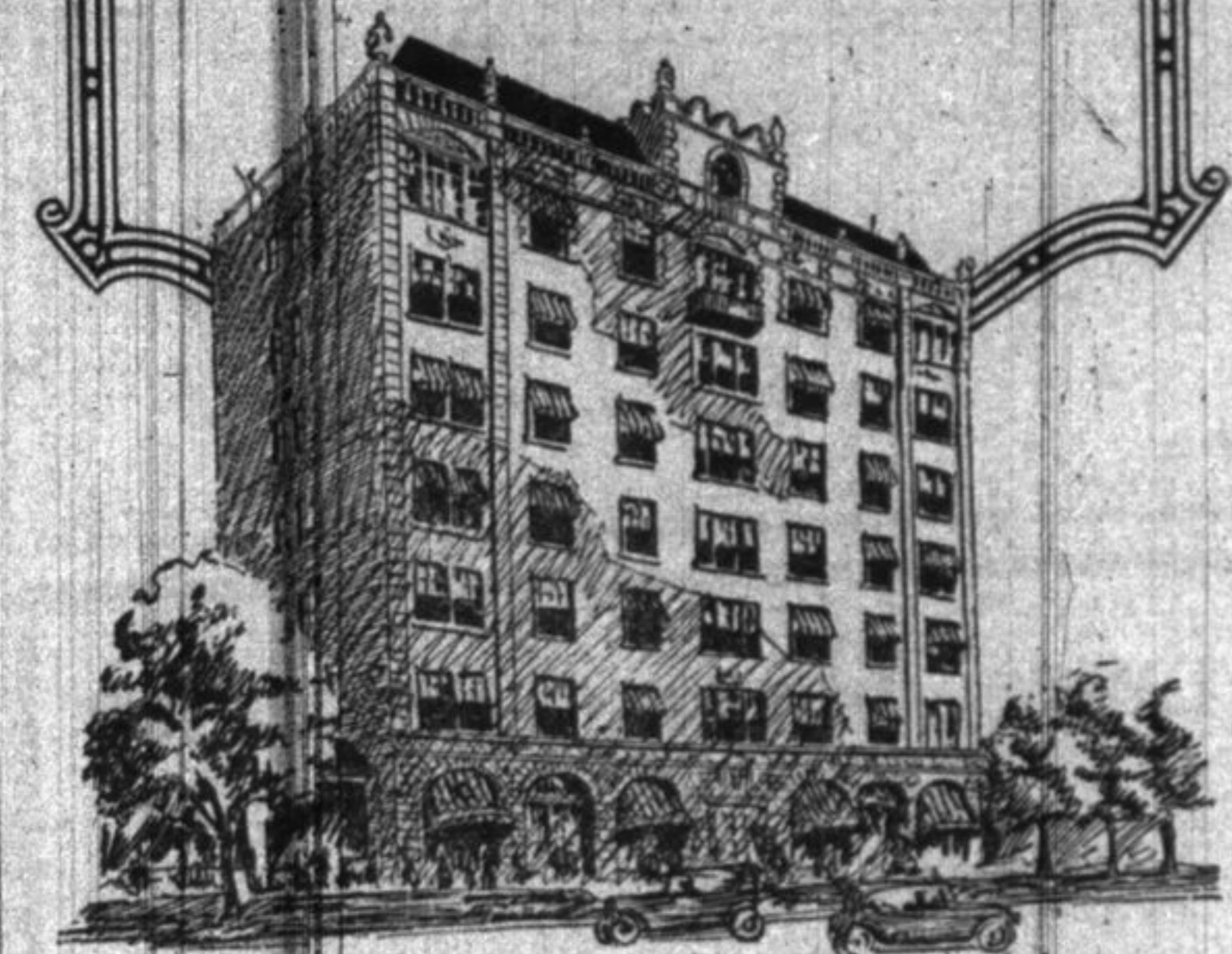
