



ANCIENT AMERICAN WORK

Product of Race Which Inhabited South America Ages Before Discovery by Europeans

In the collection of weaving and textiles at the Art Institute there are some most remarkable examples of the work of the race of people known as the Mayas, who flourished in South America ages before Pizarro broke their gentle spirit with his cruelties. One can readily recall the story of the greedy Spanish conquerors who took captive a prince of the ruling house. The Spanish commander held the prince for ransom and demanded a certain amount of gold for his release. The gold was furnished, and so readily that the cupidity of the commander was excited. He demanded more gold. It was supplied. Again were his demands repeated, and again complied with. He finally set upon the terrified people the most impossible condition that they must fill full of gold a certain room in order to get back their prince. Consternation seized the Mayas, but they set about the task with grim determination. Dispatching runners to every section of their empire they gathered the treasure in great quantities, and eventually the room was filled and their prince ransomed.

A Peaceful People
The Mayas and their successors the Incas, were a peaceful people and when the Spaniards came, they soon became subject to their conquerors, and their decline as a great race began.

Much research work has been undertaken in Peru during the past few years and considerable knowledge of the history of this strange people has been obtained. The articles of weaving now in the collection of the Art Institute were found wrapped around the bodies of persons who were of importance. It seems that the proletariat, or common working people, at death, were placed upon scaffolds and the elements all work to decompose their bodies. But the officials and members of the ruling classes were wrapped in costly garments and buried beneath the clay floors of their own households. These burial places are now found by going about the supposed site of prehistoric villages and sinking sharp sticks into the ground.

DIVING BELL FROM SPIDER'S PRODUCT

GAVE INVENTORS IDEAS

Modern Device Based in General Principles on Waterproof Web House Built By Arachnida

It is claimed that the diving bell was invented by a spider. At least we are certain that if it was not actually invented by him it was used by him long before the hydraulic engineers made one for the same purpose. The diving bell is a cupshaped body with an open end down, which is let into the water. The air is caught in the bell and keeps the water from rising beyond a certain level from any specified depth and, of course, allowing any one inside to breathe and act as if he were on dry land.

Diving Bell Improvement
The improvement of the diving bell, known as the taison, is a huge pipe that has compartments, into which air is pumped from above. The spider's bell is filled more in this manner than in the other. The name given to these little spiders is appropriate—the naids of the family of arachnida. A naid will build a little house of waterproof silk, held fast by strands fixed to the neighboring blades of grass and stones several feet under the water. He completes the entire structure before filling it with air—as if he knew that the air would tend to make it rise to the top and thus hinder the attaching of the anchors. The nata swims down from the surface with bubbles of air and turns them loose in the airy structure. The process is repeated several times until the little house is full of air. Of course, the open end of this house is down, and this has to act also as the entrance to it.

Never Get Wet
Another peculiar thing about the naids is that they never get wet. They have thousands of small hairs on their bodies which hold and keep the air from being washed off when they enter water, and so the air sticks and water cannot approach. The water beetle is probably the only other insect engineer in the naid's class. It builds a waterproof nest under water, but does not live in it. It merely lays its eggs in the nest, seals it up and leaves. The mason bee, as its name implies, is a builder of structures of stone and mortar. The nest is attached to almost any solid structure, and actually does consist of small stones cemented together with mortar. The house consists of many cells of oval shape, and into each an egg is laid. The cell is lined with silken webs by the mother, who gets out of it by a hole in the top. Before leaving, however, she hermetically seals up the cell.
