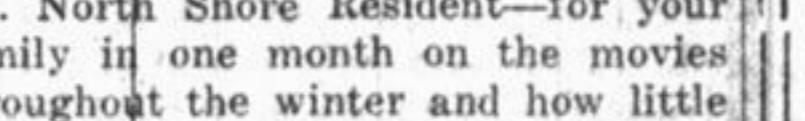
WOMAN HIKER VISITS LAKE COUNTY TOWNS
