CANADA BUILDING MANY AUTOMOBILES

Industry Has Shown Big Expansion in Recent Years; Breaks Record

The automotive industry in Canada has shown constant expansion in recent years, which reflects to a considerable extent the activities of American manufacturers who have established subsidiary operating units in the Dominion, according to reports from Canadian sources,

The number of automobiles manufactured in Canada last year exceedall previous records, reaching 101,007, or seven per cent more than the previous record output attained in 1920 and 53 per cent better than the 1921 turnout.

Total value of the output last year was \$81,956,429, or 14,906, 220 greater than the preceding year, although \$19,509,417 lower than the 1920 pro-
