#### LASKER EXPLAINS LEVIATHAN TRIP

ARRANGED BY DEMOCRATS

Refutes Many Rumors Regard ing So-Called Junket; Tells How Big Ship Handled Like All Others

World has been making sensational ttacks upon the trial trip of the Le diathan. It has alleged the trip would cost \$1,000,000 and had been arranged by Mr. A. D. Lasker as a junker for his friends. The democratic na tional committee has been parroting lose charges.

Mr. Lasker completely exposes falsity and mendacity of world's campaign in the following atement issued recently.

"I have refrained from answering hat seemed to me an absurd critieism of the trial trip to be taken by he Leviathan nekt week, but I fee recent statement issued by the emocratic national committee is such unfortunate utterance that should not go unchallenged

"It will be a matter of great the gret to the American people, I am sure, when all the facts are known that a partisan political committee has so far forgotten patriotism as to play politics on a matter which should e obviously non-partisan.

Expected It

"What I feared would happen has happened. I was one of those who advocated a ship subsidy because I believed that was the only way to insure a merchant marine in competition with the private shipping enterprises of foreign countries. I feared that if we had government operation, it would merely mean that our whole shipping problem would be confinuously a football in party politics The democrats played their part in filibustering against ship subsidy, arguing that government operation was the solution to our merchant marine problem. Now, however, at the very first opportunity, when we launching what we aspire to make the greatest ship in the world, when, indeed, the heart of every true American should beat proudly over the achievement in the reconditioning the incomparable Leviathan, we are confronted with the spectacle of political committee picking flaws and endeavoring by gross misrepresentations to muddy the waters

"What are the facts? It would appear, on reading the statement of the democratic national committee, that the trial trip of the Leviathan was suddenly conceived, and guests were invited purely as a vate junket. If that were true, the criticism would be fully justified, particularly in these days when, as President Harding rightly says, economy in government is the paramount need of America.

Truth of Matter

"The truth of the matter is that this very trial trip was fully provided by the experts engaged in December 1919, by a shipping board headed by John Barton Payne, under the democratic administration. If the critics had only taken the trouble to look up the records, they would have found that the plans and specifications for the reconditioning of the Leviathan were not hastily made but that every detail, including the testing of the great ship in the proposed trial trip, even to the last dollar that would be spent

"It is customary practice the world over to have trial trips for all vessels, but particularly extended trips before passanger ships like the Leviathan are put into regular service. I need only recall the extensive trial trips taken by the Lusitania and the

"The cost of reconditioning the Leriathan was more than \$8,000,000. The cost of the trial trip, as proposed by the experts and authorized by the board fully sixteen months ago, was \$120,000, of which \$107,000 have had to be spent, irrespective of whether a single guest was carried. It has been the universal custom on the part of shipping companies throughout the world to invite nonpaying guests on the trial trips of new vessels, in order that the complex organization and service machinery of the ship might be broken in For that purpose the experts insisted that 400 to 500 guests be asked on the Leviathan's trial trip. Invariably shipping companies invite as guests the people whose good will it is desirable to win - journalists, legislators, freight and passenger men, experters and importers, and others who could later be of aid to the ship's business.


