At the University of North Carolina Supply, though a freshman, has been used in the Varsity line-up, and Seymour is Varsity end at Swarthmore. So it goes. No effort has been made to secure a complete list; but these are enough to show the results of Rothacher's training.

Results of Training
That training leaves its mark on every boy "Coach" comes in contact with, resulting in a manlier deportment and cleaner sportsmanship. There is no yelling or swearing at boys on Rothacher's teams. A boy learns to do his best, to forget his grouch, to subordinate personal ambition to the good of the team at all times. Indeed, character-building is the main function of Coach Rothacher, winning games being only incidental to that. Lucky the lad that comes under his guidance!

This Year's Games
So far this year Deerfield-Shields has defeated Schurz with over forty-five hundred students, Lindbloom with over thirty-five hundred, Kenosha, Waukegan and Riverside. With three men out of the line-up the local team met Proviso and was defeated 7 to 3. Next Saturday, with every man in play, they will meet the great Oak Park combination, usually counted the best team in Illinois and often in the past winners of great inter-sectional championships. From the comparative size of schools it ought to be as easy for Oak Park to win from Deerfield as for Chicago to triumph over Beloit. But under Coach Rothacher the little school will prove a mighty contender and may pull out a victory as we did two years ago.
