

Expanded Wood Lath PROVED STIFFER THAN STANDARD CONSTRUCTION Comparative tests made by Robert W. Hunt & Co., Engineers

Results of Test Actual Movement of Upper Sill Lath and Expanded Sheathing Wood Lath

TDENTICAL panels with frames four feet high and eight feet long, constructed with sills and stude 7%x3% in. and studs placed 16 in, on centers, were prepared. FRAME A had one side covered with %x6 in. dressed sheathing nailed at each stud with 8D nails, and the other side covered with common lath spaced 2 in, on centers and staggered in the usual way.

FRAME B was covered on both sides with Expanded Wood Lath sheets 8 ft. long and 16 in. wide, fastened at the juncture of each rib and stud with 5D nails.
