

DEVELOPMENT OF SUPERPOWER IDEA

MUST BE MADE CLEAR

Misunderstanding and Misrepresentation Menace Which Must Be Eliminated; Progress Slow

"Like radio in its heydey, superpower appeals to the imaginations of the public, and countless enthusiasts have begun to preach the popular gospel and lead their converts to dazzling heights of fantasy," says Electrical World, a national authority.

"When the great day of superpower comes, it is made to appear, the turning of a switch will force electrical genii to serve all human needs. They will fructify the soil, waft men and materials hither and yon, turn darkness into light, metamorphose toil into silken repose, change hovels to palaces and in fact, flagellate Elysium into existence with St. Elmo's fire.

Politicians Mislead People

"It is but natural that they should be attracted principally to the dramatic aspects of this new phase of the ever-fascinating subject of electricity, and that they should be writing largely in ignorance of the very technical considerations which underlie every advance in engineering and invention.

"The interpretations of self-seeking politicians but add fuel to the flames of popular credulity and emit smoke screens behind which naked selfishness can work. Good and bad, conceptions and misconceptions, true and false—all are inextricably associated in popular fancy, and this condition may bode good or ill for superpower.

"Initiated as an essential act of evolution by the electrical industry, promising a great expansion to the public service, superpower must not be permitted to become a boomerang.

"The very term, 'superpower,' is perhaps misleading and unfortunate. It suggests super-intensity, rather than a great massing of power resources through the interconnection

sources through the interconnection of existing systems supported by the development of new ones. This must all be made clear to industry, to the press and to the public.

"It is a responsibility upon all elec-

trical men. Armed with truth and inspired by understanding, the men of the industry can bring the real superpower past all pitfalls and properly enthrone a national electricity supply as the greatest source of national prosperity and human well being. But no passive policy can be expected to prevail."

What "Superpower" Is Reduced to a definition of simple terms "Superpower" is nothing more than the interconnection of power lines carrying electricity generated at various central sections. In this may ner plants operated by coal are linked together or with those operated by water. When water power is plentiful such plants may furnish a major portion of the power, thereby saving consumption of coal. In the event of a drought the system is reversed And at all times the load can be evenly spread from sections with a ten porary low demand to those having a higher immediate need. Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Indiana and other adjacent portions of the Great Lakes district already have perfected, to a large measure, the "superpower" idea and these states are already benefit ing from it.

TRYING TO LOCATE OLDEST GAS STOVE

Public Service Company Seeking
One Longest Used in This
Section of State.

In order to find out the age and type of gas stoves which were in use throughout its territory, the Public Service company recently inaugurated an "Oldest Gas Range Contest," offering prizes of new ranges to each of the two persons having the oldest gas ranges in the districts.

Approximately 85,000 registration cards were sent out stating the condition of the award. The returns, within ten days numbered 2,000 cards. It is estimated that by the time all the registrations are in, a total of 4,500 cards will have been received.

From the registrations, it was learned that the oldest ranges in the territories circularized have been in use between 40 and 45 years.
