fires which spare neither villages, crops nor human lives; Canada is in a blaze through all her primeval woods; the lakes are covered by a veil of smoke that makes navigation dangerous and disastrous; the east, too, is parched everywhere and burning somewhere, and the flames of burning trees and crops sweep down to the ocean on the New Jersey coast; there are wars and rumors of wars in eastern Europe; there is no rest for men under the broiling sun, and insanity has become epidemic, as if the gods, wishing to destroy the race, were first making them mad; a volcano has broken out in Nevada, and sharks and other strange fish are being caught by hook and line from the docks of New ork.
