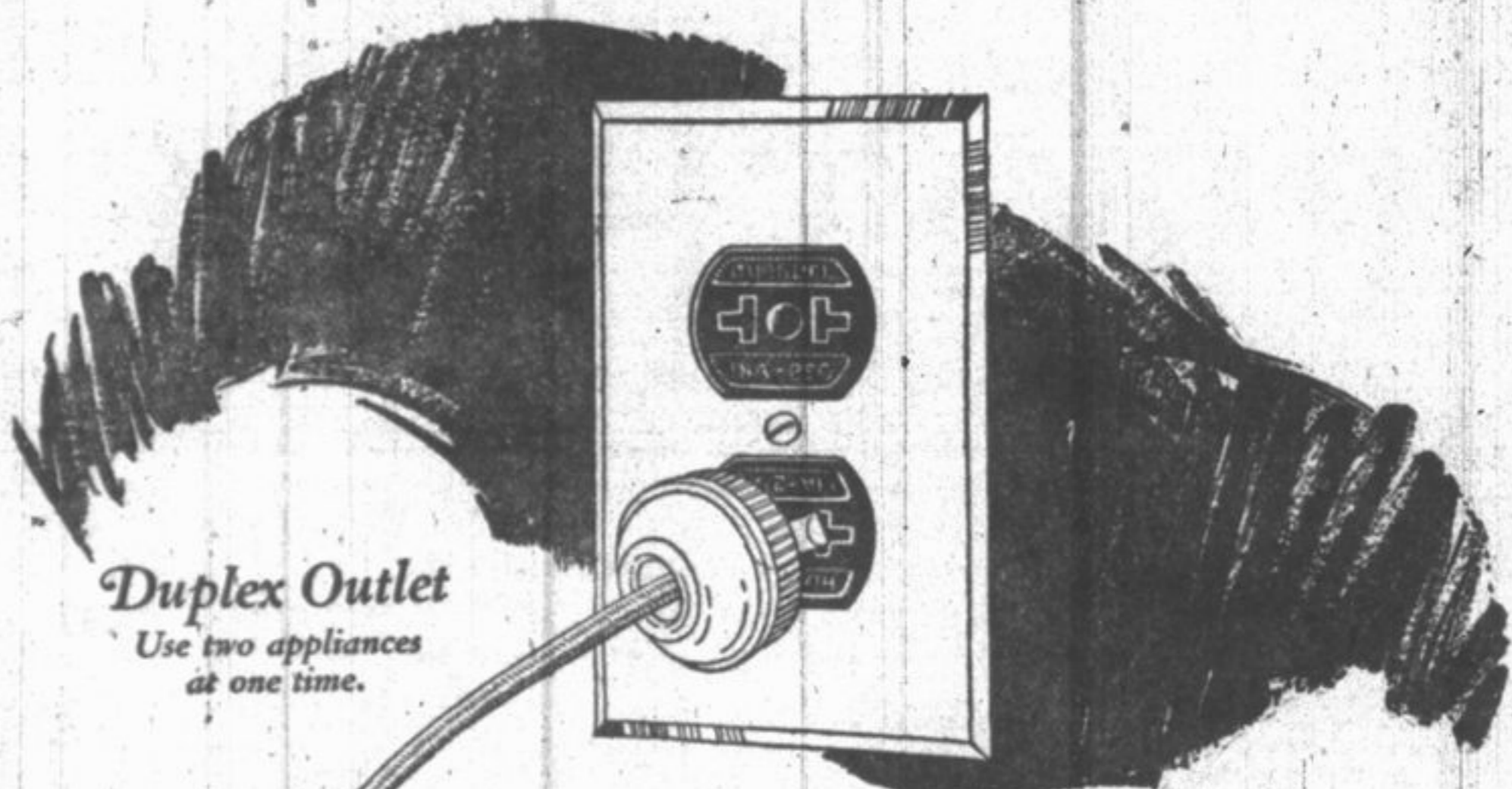

COLORED BOY WINS MARBLES TOURNNEY

FOUR THOUSAND COMPETE

Chicago Y. M. C. A. Feature Has Created Much Interest in Ranks of Youth; How Contest Made

The Chicago Y.M.C.A. has just completed a city-wide marble tournament enrolling over 4,000 boys. The winner of the championship silver loving cup was a little colored boy, Junius Jackson, and the winner of second place was also a colored boy named Peter Pate, who won the championship last year.

This tournament was an interesting democratic race, for the winner of third place was Ernest Parker, 6060 Woodlawn avenue, in the exclusive Hyde Park section. Fourth honors were won by Bernard Hoffman, 4063 Sheridan road, Chicago's wealthy north side district.

How Selected
The three best players in each grammar school were first selected in competition. These came together to decide the championship of that district of the city under the auspices of the local branch of the Y.M.C.A.

The city finals were held in Lincoln Park in the rain on Saturday afternoon, April 26.

"Since thousands of boys learn their first lessons in gambling by playing 'mibs' for keeps, we are trying to elevate the game so that they will play for fun or sport for sport's sake," said L. L. Bever, boys' secretary.

Play "Ringer"
The old-fashioned game of "ringer" was played. A ring, ten feet in diameter, is marked on the ground and each player puts two "ducks" in the center. In the old days, boys used small clay marbles for "ducks" or "mibs" but the present generation uses ngates for both ducks and shooters.

The players "lag" for a line to decide first shot. They then knuckle down on any part of the ring to hit a duck or their opponent's shooter, which gives them one duck. If they knock their opponent's shooter from the ring, the latter is knocked out of the game, and all the ducks he has secured go to the lucky shooter.

A number of boys and their dads from suburban towns came in to see these championship games.
