**HAYNES EXPLAINS
NEW DRY RULING**

MATERIALS' USE BARRED

Statement by Prohibition Head
In State Tries to Make
Clear Sections On
This Subject

Federal Commissioner R. A. Haynes has issued the following statement:

There have been so many inquiries concerning the provisions of section 2,200 of regulations 60, revised March, 1924, effective May 1, 1924, that it seems advisable to further explain, and to call attention to section 18, title II of the national prohibition act, which reads as follows:

"It shall be unlawful to advertise, manufacture, sell or possess for sale any utensil, contrivance, machine, preparation, compound, tablet, substance, formula, direction, or recipe advertised, designed, or intended for use in the unlawful manufacture of intoxicating liquor."

Section 25 of said title and act provides in part as follows:

Text of Law
"It shall be unlawful to have or possess any liquor or property designed for the manufacture of liquor intended for use in violating this title or which has been so used, and no property rights shall exist in any such liquor or property."

Section 2,200, of regulations 60, to which reference is made, practically paraphrases section 18 herein quoted.

From the foregoing, it is apparent that the sale of sugar, fresh or dried fruits, malt extract, with or without hops, clarifiers, or any other material with knowledge and design on the part of the vendor that the purchaser intends to use it in the production of intoxicating liquor for beverage purposes, in the home or elsewhere, or under circumstances from which such use might reasonably be deduced, is a violation of law.

Under the eighteenth amendment to the federal constitution, and the national prohibition act and supplement thereto of November 23, 1921, intoxicating liquors may not be manufactured in the home or elsewhere for beverage purposes and may not be manufactured for non-beverage purposes, except under permit, as provided by the national prohibition act.

Section Three
Section 3 of the national prohibition act provides that:

"No person shall on or after the date when the eighteenth amendment to the constitution of the United States goes into effect, manufacture, sell, barter, transport, import, export, deliver, furnish, or possess any intoxicating liquor except as authorized in this act, and all the provisions of this act shall be liberally construed to the end that the use of intoxicating liquor as a beverage may be prevented.

It is not to be understood that the department has issued any regulations, or intends to issue any, which will interfere with the legitimate sale of materials of this character.

It is obvious that dried fruits cannot be used for making non-intoxicating fruit juices exclusively for use in the home, under the provisions of section 20, title II of the national prohibition act, and notice to that effect was issued in a mimeograph of October 7, 1920, pertaining to the subject.

Limits Use
The possession of fresh fruit is a pre-requisite to the making of fruit juices and fruit juices made from such fresh fruit, exclusively for use in the home, may not be used as beverages after they become intoxicating.

There is no new legislation on this subject, but attention is merely called to the provisions of law and the interpretation thereof by the department. The regulations are regarded as being within the purview of the statute.

**FLOATING ISLAND
GROWING IN SIZE**

Professor Describes How Lake
County Cedar Lake Bog
Is Developed

Cedar lake's floating island of bog in Lake county is growing rapidly, according to an announcement today by Dr. W. G. Waterman of Northwestern university, who is making a special study of the island.

The bog appeared about six years ago and, at that time, was only a few yards, across. It now is about twenty-five yards wide the professor stated, and will almost support the weight of a man.

Such islands originate, the professor explained, from a group of free floating plants such as aquatics and pond weeds. These in time are reinforced by plants which have their roots in the bottom and foliage on top of the water.

As the bog becomes firmer, bog shrubs and dwarf birches appear. Finally, tamarack trees grow from the mat, and in the course of years the island becomes like any other piece of land.
