CORPORATIONS PAY STATE \$5,000,000

Collections of Fees Under New Code Greatly Increased, Report Says

The new corporation code of Illinois, enacted under the administration of Secretary of State Louis L. Emmerson, has resulted in total fee collections amounting to almost \$5,-000,000 a year. This money goes directly into the treasury and serves to reduce the amount to be raised by general taxation.

Prior to the beginning of Secre tary Emmerson's administration, fees paid in by corporations amounted to only about \$500,00 per year. Last year, foreign corporations paid in \$1,625,000 and domestic corporations \$3,045,000. There are a total of 30,-000 corporations.
