FATHER AND SON MOVEMENT GROWS
SPREADING OVER WORLD

Originated in U. S. and Other Countries Adopting Plan, Says Speaker at Geneva

The Father and Son movement, which had its origin in America where it has become a recognized institution, is spreading over the whole world. This was indicated in a speech on August 15, at Geneva, Switzerland, by Walter W. Head, chairman of the National Father and Son committee of the United States, before the World's committee of the Y. M. C. A. "More than twenty nations," he said, "observe Father and Son week. In the United States alone upwards of three millions of fathers and sons joined in events during the past year."

Originated in 1907 The Father and Son movement originated at a Y. M. C. A. banquet of fathers and sons at Providence, R. I., in 1907, Mr. Head reminded his hearers. He said further: "Only as the fundamental principles of world brotherhood are recognized and accepted by the people of the world, can we ever hope for world peace. The men who are to direct the destiny of the nations of the world during the next generation are now young lads who are in our homes today. What greater privilege has a man to give of himself as a companion, teacher, adviser, and an inspiration to his son, who tomorrow steps into responsibilities the significance of which we cannot conceive. For Every Man

"Every man, whether or not he bears the physical relation of father to son, should give serious consideration to his own life, the ideals for which he stands, that his example will always prove to be an inspiration to the boy life of today in encouraging the spirit of world brotherhood."

"In the United States we believe it most appropriate to observe National Father and Son week at that period of the year when Armistice day comes. This has proved to be an opportune time not only to pay honor and respect to the millions of fathers and sons who gave their lives for the ideal of world brotherhood, but a time for the fathers and sons who survive to reconsecrate themselves to life for that same great objective—world brotherhood, world peace. We are, therefore, planning for the observance this year to come during the week of November 9-16."

Plan Universal Adoption
The World's committee of the Y. M. C. A. is planning to co-operate in making the Father and Son movement universal. Details are to be worked out by the boy's division staff, of which E. M. Robinson, former senior secretary of the Y. M. C. A. boy's work in America, is now secretary.

The Chicago Y. M. C. A. co-operated with 54 local churches of all denominations and the Chicago Church federation in observation of Father and Son week last year and it is expected that several hundred local churches will hold father and son dinners and outings the week of November 9-16 this year.

WIRE KITE "STRING" NEARLY KILLS MAN

Contact with High Power Circuit Causes Peculiar Accident

Bardly burned by coming in contact with two 33,000 volt transmission wires, while flying a kite, Theo Johnson, aged 22, of Waukegan was taken to the Victory Memorial hospital last week, while electrical engineers were puzzled at his miraculous escape from instant electrocution.

Johnson, who was flying the kite with a fine copper wire instead of a string, in the neighborhood of Belvidere street and McAllister avenue, about 7 o'clock Monday evening, had his legs and back badly burned when the wire came in contact with the high voltage wires which supply Grayslake with light and power.

His clothes were on fire when persons in the neighborhood reached him. The work of rescuing him was extremely difficult because of the fact that both transmission wires snapped and were hissing and sputtering, and threatened destruction of anyone who might come in contact with them.

The only thing that saved the young man's life was the fact that the wire he used on the kite was extremely light and melted before he got the full charge of the load.



IDENTICAL panels with frames four feet high and eight feet long, constructed with sills and studs 7 1/2 x 3 1/2 in. and studs placed 16 in. on centers, were prepared. FRAME A had one side covered with 3/8 x 6 in. dressed sheathing nailed at each stud with 8D nails, and the other side covered with common lath spaced 2 in. on centers and staggered in the usual way. FRAME B was covered on both sides with Expanded Wood Lath sheets 8-ft. long and 16 in. wide, fastened at the juncture of each rib and stud with 5D nails. In testing these panels the bottom sill was clamped to the base of testing machine and the pull applied to the top sill in the direction of its length. Expanded Wood Lath, by this test, has been proven much stiffer than the old standard construction. But added to this advantage are its high insulating qualities and the much lower construction cost when used for either exterior stucco or interior plaster.
