Continent Construction company, \$50,442; Hoeffler & company, \$50,587; E. P. Strandberg company, \$44,950; Bates & Rogers Construction company, \$59,850.

### Council Session

At the council and board sessions Friday night S. E. Johnson was granted permit to extend city water mains into his Roslyn Circle subdivision, provided the work is done under city specification and supervision of the city engineer and the owner to pay entire costs, the contractor to give the city an indemnifying bond of \$20,000.

Approval and acceptance was accorded the plat of the Deere Park subdivision, subject to execution of owner's certificate on said plat and reapportioning of special assessments against the tract. Approval and acceptance was given plat of Middleton's subdivision of Lot 4, Block 33, subject to reapportioning of assessments.

Baird & Warner were granted permit to construct sewer and water mains in their Deere Park subdivision under the usual conditions imposed by the city in such matters, contractor to give bond, F. B. Thomas was granted permit to extend sewer and water mains in Oakmont subdivision under similar conditions as the others. Alvin C. Green was given permission to construct temporary macadamized streets in Greenwood Gardens subdivision.

### Present Reports

Engineers Windes & Marsh presented report and estimate No. 3 and final for the Charles M. Porter contract for system of sanitary sewers in Sunset Terrace subdivision, showing a balance of \$14,530.97, which was allowed. Engineers' estimate and report No. 6 and final for the Highways Construction company on Ravinia Woods improvement showed \$12,919.13 due, and which was allowed. Report and estimate No. 1 for Charles M. Porter company on southeast sanitary system showed \$1,300 due, which was allowed.

Resolutions were adopted providing that the original plans be adhered to in the matter of paving St. Johns avenue from Laurel to Sheridan and from Cedar avenue to Roger Williams and other streets, and the corporation counsel was instructed to prepare estimates and ordinances, the required public hearings having been held.

A resolution was adopted providing for advertising for bids for paving St. Johns from Elm to Central and East Park from Sheridan to St. Johns, bids to be received at 5:15 p. m. October 10.

The engineer was instructed to prepare estimate of cost of construction of the West Park avenue system of water mains.

At the special meeting of the local improvement board Tuesday afternoon final acceptance was voted for the connected system of sanitary sewers in Sunset Terrace, built by the Charles M. Porter company, the cost being \$497,747.03, and for the Ravinia Woods paving by the Highways Construction company, at a cost of \$120,023.70.

## NEW YORK EDITOR IS TO SPEAK HERE

Character of large metropolitan newspapers, among them the Chicago Tribune. He is the grandson of William Lloyd Garrison the famous Boston anti-slavery leader, and has made a distinguished record of fearless public service in his own right, as a champion of the victims of all kinds of injustice, of the negro, of oppressed nationalities, and of the embattled truth in many campaigns.

His paper, The Nation, which reaches the thinking public from coast to coast, was the originator a few years ago of an investigation by an American committee of one hundred of the facts of the distressing civil war in Ireland, in which hatred and a long series of angry atrocities, had obscured the truth. The Nation, likewise, caused a Congressional investigation in 1923 of the uninvited military occupation, by the American war department, of the Republic of Haiti and San Domingo, an investigation which resulted in a series of shocking exposures, finally, in the withdrawal of American marines from this land.

### Condemned Treaty

Mr. Villard himself was the first prominent American journalist and his paper the first journal to condemn the betrayal of American ideals, of justice, and of the truth, embodied in the iniquitous Treaty of Versailles, and the verdict of Mr. Villard, passed in 1919, concerning the economic stupidities as well as the moral obliquities of that so-called peace treaty has been sustained and confirmed by the prolonged chaos of Europe and the inconclusive and feeble attempts at readjustment which have made in many conferences since the war.

Mr. Villard and his father before him, owned and edited for many years the New York Evening Post, the most highly respected and independent of the New York evening newspapers, until its sale by the former, in 1921, to the Munsey interests. He will speak in Evanston on Sunday evening, and at noon will be the dinner guest of Horizon house, 843 Lincoln avenue, Highland Park.
