MUSIC KNOWLEDGE GROWTH PREDICTED

INTEREST TO BE GENERAL
Professor Declares That in 50 Years This Art Will Have Wide Influence Upon Human Life

As a result of enlightened instruction in the public schools, it is likely that the person of average education fifty years hence "will have that contact with music which best expresses his own nature and in which a cultivated sensitiveness to beautiful music will contribute to a richer and fuller life." Such is the opinion of Prof. Osbourne McConathy, head of the department of public school and community music at Northwestern university music school, who spoke recently before the North Central Indiana Teachers association at South Bend.

Conducts Mental Tests
Prof. McConathy who has been conducting novel mental tests upon children of the Evanston, Ill., public schools for several years, is convinced that the presence of musical talent can be discovered and gauged in a little child almost as soon as the youngster enters school. By this method, Prof. McConathy has brought out some exceptional singers and instrumental artists from among Evanston's public school host-children whose parents at first scoffed at the idea that their offspring possessed musical talent.

Musical Opportunities
"Instead of the old music plan which consisted solely of class singing lessons with greater or less emphasis on music reading, we find the public schools offering a wide choice of musical opportunities to the pupils," said the Northwestern university teacher today. "The new public school music plan involves three fields of thought: first, a study of the child to determine his capacities and his interest in music; second, a differentiated course in music wherein each child receives instruction in accordance with the findings; and third, some form of attainment tests to determine the success of the child's work."

Include Old Lessons
"The differentiated courses of today include the old class singing lessons which apparently will remain as the basal work in school music; instruction in listening to music with intelligent discrimination, and special instruction in piano playing and playing the instruments of the orchestra and band for children adapted to such study."

Road Improvement Ballot

Shall an Act of the General Assembly of Illinois entitled, "An Act in relation to the construction by the State of Illinois of durable hard-surfaced roads upon public highways and the provision of means for the payment of the cost thereof by an issue of bonds of the State of Illinois, which, in substance, provides for the construction by the State acting through its Department of Public Works and Highways, subject to the Governor's approval, of a Statewide system of hard roads, all routes described, for initial and maintenance, and for conditional compensation for payment of said roads, and for such Act; authorize the State to contract a debt for such purpose and to issue \$100,000,000 of serial bonds, bearing interest at not to exceed four per cent; appropriate said sum to said department; levy a tax sufficient to pay said interest as it shall accrue, and to pay off said bonds within 25 years from issuance, but provides that such payments may be made from other sources of revenue and requires moneys in the Motor Vehicle Law "Road Fund" to be first used for such payments (subject to its use of payments of principal and interest of prior State road bonds) and such direct tax to be omitted in any year in which sufficient money from other sources of revenue has been appropriated to meet such payment for such year; provides for publication and for submission to the People; makes the provisions for payment of such interest and bonds irrevocable; and pledges faith of State to the making of such payments; so in full force and effect?"

Election November 4 Paid by Auto Fees No Direct Tax

Illinois collected this year to October 13th, \$11,424,720 in auto license fees, or approximately \$3,500,000 more than enough to make the average yearly payment of principal and interest on both the old \$60,000,000 bond issue and the proposed \$100,000,000 bond issue.

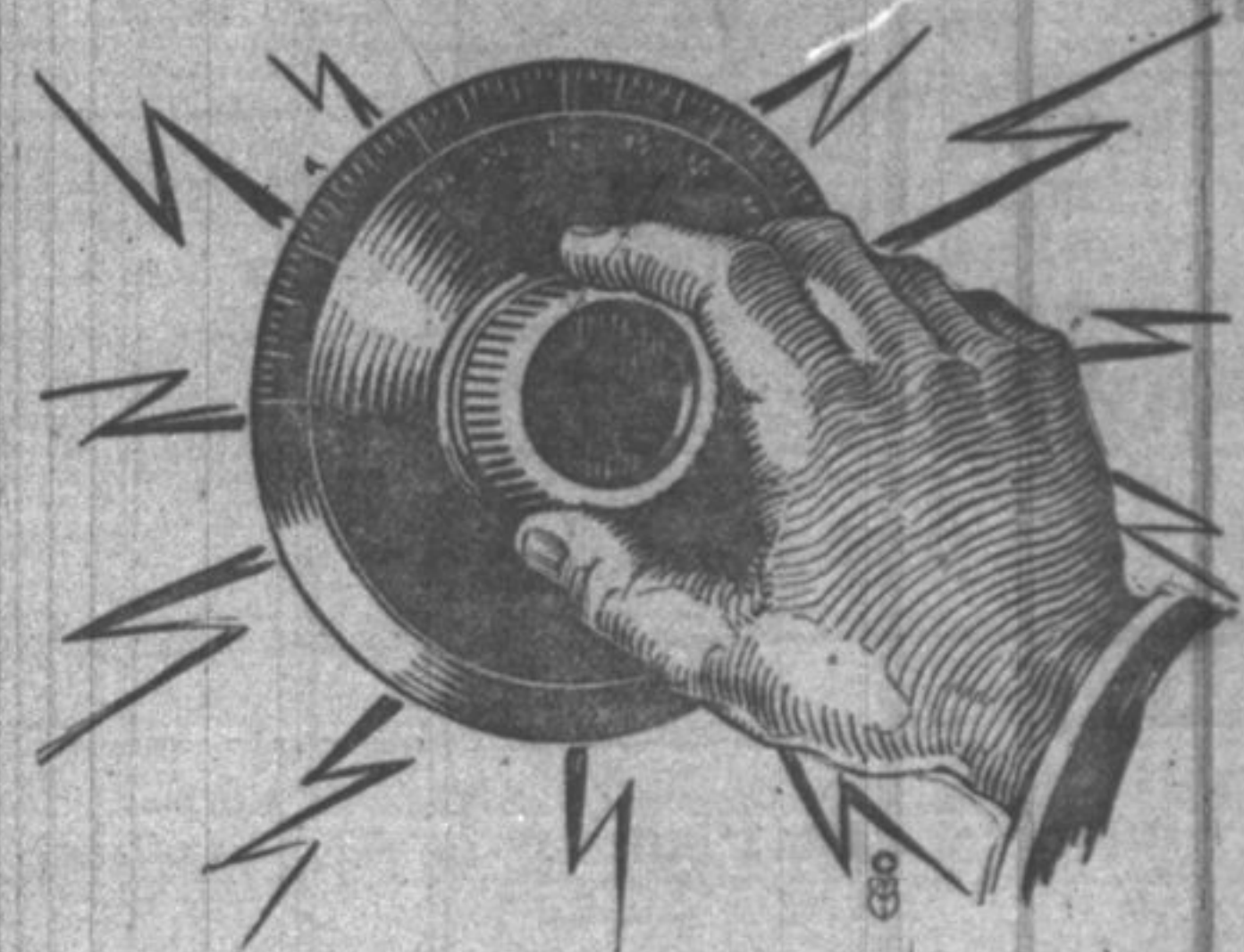

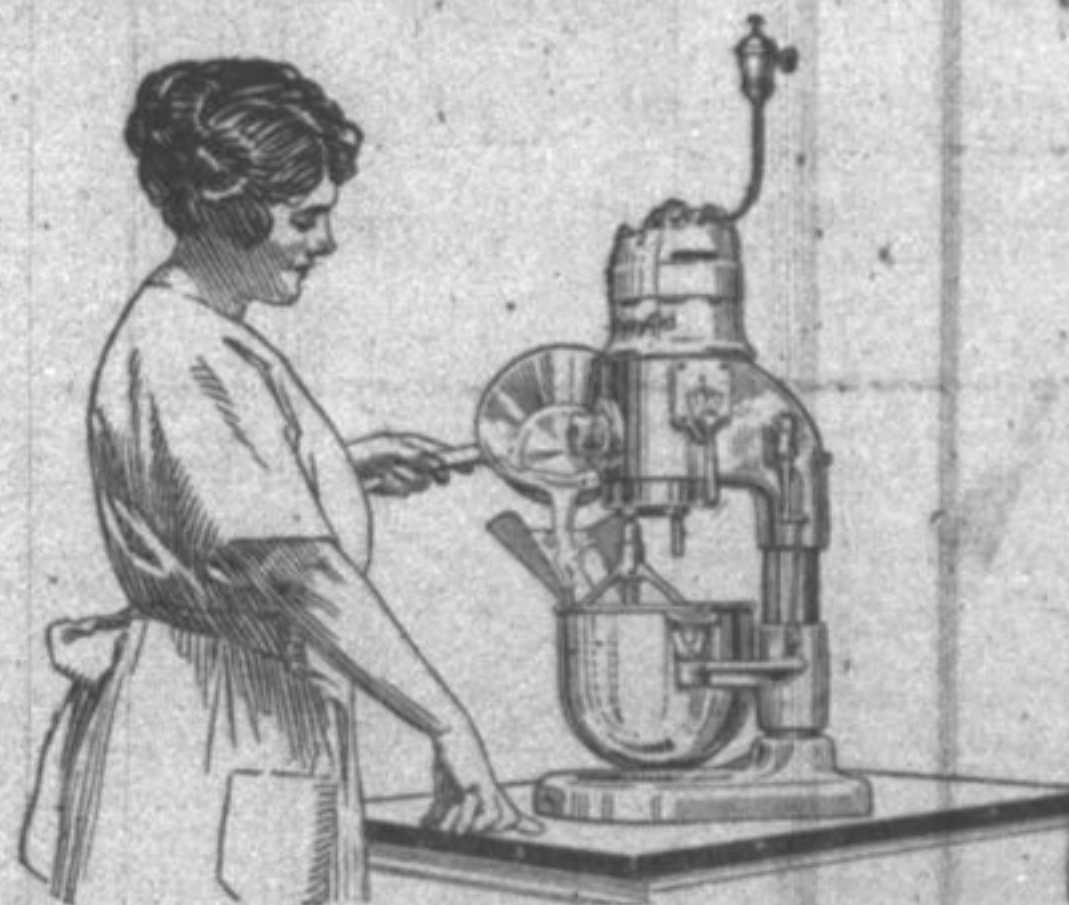
