

Among those killed in Lake county during the past few years were William Hana, North Chicago, who was burned to death at Lake Villa, and William Peterson, of Winthrop Harbor, shot to death while trying to capture Ignatz Potz, now serving life sentence for murder.



Republican party candidates were chosen by the voters of their party; the party is responsible for their selection; they are responsible to the party as well as to the public.
