DIFFICULTIES MET GETTING LICENSES FOR OPERATION OF AUTOS

Simple Renewal Is Easy, but When Plates Transferred During Year Hard to Clear Way

"What difficulties do motorists encounter in applying for state vehicle licenses?" A bulletin issued by the home district department of the Chicago Motor club tells of some of the tribulations of the man applying for a license.

"The motorist who is simply renewing his license has little or no trouble. It is the man who has sold his car and who is getting a license for his new car, or the man who buys a car in the middle of the year, who is likely to have trouble.

"Frequently a motorist will buy a new car in the middle of the year, and he will simply transfer the license plates to the new car, without notifying the secretary of state, then when he applies for his new license in December or January, the secretary of state sends back his application blank and requests him to record the transfer which had not been sent to the automobile department at the time the transfer was made.

"When a car is sold the owner must remove the plates and the purchaser must procure new plates. If you sell a car, and buy a new one, you may transfer the plates by sending notice to the secretary of state. You are required to give the name and address of the person to whom you sold your car, together with the license number, motor number, and horse power. Then you must give a complete description of the new car.

Must Pay Difference

"If the horsepower of the new car is greater than the old car, you must pay the difference between the fee charged for the lower horsepower and the higher horsepower, plus one dollar for the transfer fee. The year is divided into two periods. Any car purchased between July 1, and December 31, takes the semi annual fee. In other words, if you buy a car in December you must pay the semi annual fee the same as if you bought the car in July. If you buy a car any time from January 1, to June 30, you must pay the annual fee."

USES LOUD SPEAKER TO PREVENT PANIC When Fire Breaks Out At Salt Lake Rodeo

The first emergency test ever made of a loud speaker in time of impending danger to life and property occurred at Salt Lake City, Utah, at the recent fall rodeo festivities. Fire broke out in a grandstand packed with human beings intently watching the wild west demonstration in the arena.

Immediately there was a stampede for the ground and all notice of the wild pranks of the buckaroo in the arena was forgotten while the program came to an abrupt end. Frantic and excited, the crowd started to make its way to safety.

A loud speaker for the use of the announcers had been installed and no sooner had the cry of fire gone forth than the man at the little instrument took in the situation at a glance and began to talk to the crowd and warn people to be calm, so that all would have plenty of time to get out.

"Be calm and go towards the north," came the warning from the loud speaker "Don't stop to watch the flames. You will block someone else from getting away from the heat. Keep moving north—everybody."

The man at the horn talked constantly to the crowd and every word was heard. Not a single person was injured, and everyone got out in time. No human voice without the aid of an amplifier could have commanded the surging army of excited people.

EXTEND PHONE LINE TO GRAND CANYON

One of the last of the widely known places in the United States to become accessible by telephone is the El Tovar hotel on the rim of the Grand Canyon. Telephone connection with the outside world has now been completed by the 240-mile wire to Phoenix, Arizona. The wire connects with the new transcontinental line between Chicago and Los Angeles, which is the longest through telephone circuit in the world.

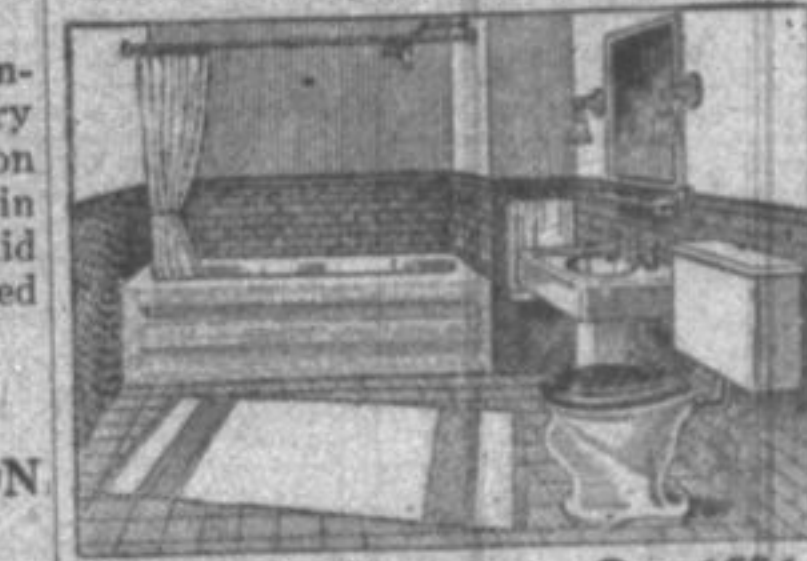

Washington, D. C.—The Department of Commerce has approved a "people's plumbing code" with the hope that it may be adopted by states and municipalities. It was announced. The bill is for the protection of the public "from insanitary plumbing, the use of defective and cheap material and improper installation." The code was prepared by a special committee appointed by Secretary Hoover and headed by William C. Groeniger of Cleveland.
