AMERICAN AID IS SAVING ARMENIANS

BY CARING FOR ORPHANS

Ancient People Given New Lease Of Life After Centuries of Persecution; Reclaiming Waste Lands

Centuries of persecution and suffering has decimated the ancient Armenian peoples and has finally driven them from their former patrimony. Had it not been for the generosity of American people here in the United Sates and the heroic self sacrifice of Americans with their helpers, across the seas, in the Near East, these people would have all perished and their remembrance would be but the record of history

But they did not all perish and, although there is still much suffering in the Near East and but little to pass around among the many who are in need, the Near East relief are assisting at the rebirth of a nation in the Republic of Armenia in the Russian Caucasus.

Prepared For Citizenship
The orphans are being cared for in the orphanages and prepared for useful citizenship in the state. Of the work so done by Near East relief much could be said and words are so weak in their power to express the full measure of sacrificial, self-denying service that is being accomplished in this respect. But outside of this work there are other projects being carried out that are perhaps just as great and certainly very vital to the development of the Armenian republic

Large trarts of waste land are being reclaimed by Near East relief under the encouragement of the governing body of the republic. This gives profitable work to orphans and others and gives promise of an adequate food supply in the future years. The organization has aided in the revival of cotton growing, a crop that will give work and raw material to the people. Farm colonies of orphan boys have been established where modern methods of agriculture are taught, which methods those boys will eventually be able to practice for themselves and teach to others who are still tilling the soil in the primitive fashion. High grade cattle have been introduced and also hogs, as a resistance to the Siberian plague. Near East relief has inaugurated plans for opening an area of virgin land to homeless farmers who have been dispossessed of their former homes by forcible deportation by the Turks. In these and other ways the foundations are being solidly laid for future building. Agriculture, the basic industry, is being developed; other industries are being taught; education of a high type is being given to thousands of orphan children, and who can deny the statement, in the face of this evidence, that we are assisting at "The rebirth of a nation."

Huge Task This is but one part of the huge task that is being carried on by Near East relief in the countries of the Near East. Funds are urgently needed to continue the work of building what has been saved from the wreckage of the war; food, clothes, medicine and equipment are inadequate to the pressing demands in all parts of the Near East. The work must continue, if what has been done is to be preserved, and the destiny of thousands hang in the balance, dependent upon individual American generosity.
