The estimated cost shall include tile discs in the ends of all dead ended drains, all trenching, laying, backfilling, and removal of all surplus excavated materials. All of the above specified concrete pipe shall be constructed of Portland cement concrete composed by volume of one (1) part Portland cement, two (2) parts sand, and four (4) parts gravel mixed with water to make a quaking mass. Each of the eight (8) foot sections of thirty-six (36) inch concrete pipe shall be reinforced

with twenty-four (24) three-eighths (3/8) inch round steel reinforcing bars eleven (11) feet five (5) inches long, twelve (12) three-eighths (3/8) inch round steel reinforcing bars eight (8) feet three (3) inches long, and two (2) pieces of steel reinforcing wire mesh (weighing one and three hundredths (1.03) pounds per square foot), eight (8) inches wide and eleven (11) feet eight (8) inches long. Each of the four (4) foot sections of thirty-six (36) inch concrete pipe shall be reinforced with one (1) piece of steel reinforcing wire mesh (weighing sixty-five hundredths (0.65) pounds per square foot), forty-eight (48) inches wide and eleven (11) feet one (1) inch long. Each of the four (4) foot sections of the thirty (30) inch concrete pipe shall be reinforced with one (1) piece steel reinforcing wire mesh (weighing sixty-five hundredths (0.65) pounds per square foot), forty-eight (48) inches wide and nine (9) feet five (5) inches long.
