SEEKING TWIN OF ANTHROPOID TOOTH
EXPEDITION IN NEBRASKA

Trying to Find Mate to Famous Million-Dollar Molar in the Place Where First One Was Found

The American Museum of Natural History has sent another expedition to Nebraska to search for a twin of the so-called "million-dollar tooth" which has been held to be the only evidence in existence that a higher ape or a sub-human type inhabited the North American continent one or two million years ago.

Reconstructed

The "million-dollar tooth" was dropped by a nervous workman, who let it fall as he heard that valuation placed on it, but it has been reconstructed and is as good as ever for scientific purposes. Other specimens of the same kind are badly wanted, however, because this particular high-priced tooth is so worn that it is not possible to say whether it most resembles a human tooth, a chimpanzee tooth or the molar of the Java man, called Pithecanthropus Erectus.

Hundreds of thousands of bones of extinct animals have been found in an ancient flood plane in Nebraska, but only one of these teeth has been found there, a fact which is accounted for by the cunning of the supposed human ancestor, which was already too weatherwise and forehanded to be caught in the great river overflows which swept away less astute and resourceful animals by the million.

Careful Search to Be Made

The search for the tooth will be carried on by digging parties in Nebraska at sites near which the original tooth was found. Relics of ancient animals of all kinds will be sought in great deposits where the victims of ancient floods were piled up, and everything will be sieved and minutely searched over for teeth of all kinds, which are more enduring than any other kind of relics.

Found by Geologist

The original "million-dollar tooth" or Hesperorhynchus tooth was found by Harold J. Cook, a consulting geologist of Agate, Neb., who suspected it to be anthropoid. It was identified as anthropoid, and as the first anthropoid relic to be found in the Western Hemisphere, by Professor Henry Fairchild Osborn, president of the American Museum of Natural History, whose conclusions have been confirmed by many detailed researches. The tooth has recently been accepted by G. Elliot Smith and other distinguished European anthropologists as proof that being of the higher ape and possibly of the lower human stock found their way to America in prehistoric times, possibly crossing the Mongolia on a land connection which then existed with Alaska. A similar tooth recently found in Northern Mongolia suggests that the climate might once have permitted migration by this route.

FEDERAL AID FOR BRIDGING STREAMS

Government Assists in Problem of Rivers on Boundaries of States, Etc.

One of the most helpful results of Federal aid to road construction has been the bridging of major streams which it has encouraged and made possible, according to the annual report of the Bureau of Public Roads of the United States Department of Agriculture. Such streams are, in many cases, the boundaries of counties or states, and the necessity of securing joint action of the authorities of the two political divisions, coupled with the inadequacy of funds available, has made the construction of modern structures over wide rivers an almost hopeless problem. Yet it is evident that no continuous road system is possible without bridging these barriers.

RADIO THEATRE GETS PINS FOR ADMISSION

When the mythical Woodshed Theater was built over radio by Ford and Glenn Rowell, the "Lullaby Boys" of WLS, the Sears-Robuck station, Chicago, they announced to their radio audience that "reserved seats" in the air would be reserved on the payment of two pins. They did not specify the kind, so thousands of pins came by mail to WLS Woodshed Theater—small pins, safety pins of all sizes and even clothes pins. The biggest pin, especially made, was 36 inches long and about two inches thick. This was engraved in honor of Ford and Glenn, and was presented by the members of the Kenosha Club,

of the Nash Motor company, Kenosha, Wis. Up to date more than 5,000 pins have been received for the Woodshed Theater's mythical auditorium. Besides the program put on by Ford and Glenn, many of the lullaby tots, members of the WLS Lullaby Hour club, produce plays of a juvenile type, in which the boys and girls are the actors and actresses.

REAL ESTATE SOON AN EXACT SCIENCE

Dealer of Future Will Be Professor and Educated in His Line

The real estate dealer of the new day will be trained in his vocation, even as the engineer, the dentist, the lawyer, the physician is trained in his. In order to cover the wide range of information which the realtor needs, the committee on educational courses of the National association of Real Estate boards has outlined a curriculum covering 12 subjects. Already three books for this course have been published and three others are promised, says Ernest M. Fisher in School Life, a publication of the Department of the Interior, bureau of education. In addition an extension course by mail is planned by the American Real Estate institute, a department of the national association.

About 30 universities and colleges have either adopted a part of the course or are seriously considering it. Mr. Fisher states, and the national association, realizing that the setting up of higher requirements and standards will dignify the profession and bring into it men of higher ability, recommends that universities and colleges permit undergraduate students who desire to choose real estate as a major study.
