DEFINES MEANING OF "SUPER-POWER"

Electricity Supply Distributed Over Wide Areas from Central Plants

What is the correct definition of "Super-Power," the much discussed phrase which has been applied to the greater development in electric light and power service which has come within the last 10 years?

R. R. Schuchardt, chief electrical engineer of the Commonwealth Edison company and chairman of the Great Lakes District Power Survey committee of the National Electric Light association, contributed this definition in an interview on the progress of electric development: "Super-power means modern electricity supply systems in which electricity is economically generated in steam or water power stations, or both, and is distributed for the benefit of population over wide areas."

Elaborating on this definition, Mr. Schuchardt said: "The many things to which, in several fields, the prefix 'Super' has been applied in the years since the war are but the natural development in those fields."

"A greater size or intensity or area influenced is inevitable with progress, and so it is in the case of power. The use of the term, in the public mind, attaches to it a quality which is the real characteristic of electric power, for the electricity supply industry has brought an abundance of cheap and clean power to industries and comforts and conveniences to homes wherever its lines have gone. Electric power has this definitely to its credit. To my mind, the term 'Super' is not misapplied in this instance, for it has been a tremendous development and the future holds far greater things for the people of this country."

MOTORISTS WARNED ABOUT INTERURBANS

Motorists sometimes regard the Interurban lines as railroads and hence forget that these lines run local cars which stop to discharge passengers, according to the accident prevention department of the Chicago Motor club. Accidents have happened where people have alighted from the Interurban cars on the concrete highways. This is especially true on the highway between Joliet and Lockport and between Lemont and Chicago.

The club accident prevention department urges motorists to regard the Interurban car as they would a street car in the city and to stop when passengers are boarding or alighting.
