PORK PRODUCTS AID ILLINOIS EXPORTS

FOREIGN SHIPMENTS BIG
State Finished Fourth of All In Union In 1924; Eleven Had Exports Valued \$100,000,000

Illinois, with merchandise exports in 1923 totaling \$239,314,270, finished fourth among the different states of the Union in the struggle for export markets, according to statistics just released by the Department of Commerce. The total foreign shipments of the United States for the year under review amounted to \$4,498,151,356. Pennsylvania, just ahead of Illinois in the race, had a safe margin in trade of nearly \$54,000,000, while California, the runner-up, fell behind Illinois to the sum of about \$5,000,000.

Lard shipments valued at \$45,494,919, and pork amounting to \$20,919,564, contributed the greatest help in keeping up Illinois' export prestige. Other important commodities shipped abroad were wheat, amounting to \$37,317,870; agricultural machinery totaling \$21,949,424; "other" machinery, \$20,400,766; iron and steel, \$8,795,077; and cornstarch, valued at \$6,303,069. Items of lesser importance on the list were vehicles, \$5,309,174; cereals, \$4,722,327; sausage casings, \$3,890,921; oleo oil, \$2,896,442; wheat flour, \$2,147,387; and tye, \$2,018,988.

Eleven states showed export totals amounting to over \$100,000,000 for the year. They were Texas, with figures of \$737,218,927; New York, \$731,593,502; Pennsylvania, \$293,288,153; Illinois, \$239,314,270; California, \$234,684,210; New Jersey, \$223,921,264; Louisiana, \$222,847,224; Michigan, \$177,876,654; Virginia, \$150,198,225; Ohio, \$133,559,362; and Massachusetts, with merchandise valuations of \$114,418,430. Minnesota, with shipments valued at \$99,880,490, was just outside

of the first eleven, while Nevada, with exports amounting to but \$233,413, brought up the rear of the entire list.

First Statistical Report
This is the first time in the history of Government trade statistics, according to Dr. Julius Klein, director of the Bureau of Foreign and Domestic Commerce, under whose charge the figures were compiled, that an attempt has been made to show the relative yearly standing of the different states and regions of the Union in the never ending struggle for foreign trade. Formerly, official trade figures gave only the port from which shipments were cleared. Inland producers, desirous of finding out what agricultural and manufactured goods came from their regions wanted the Commerce Department to adopt some other system. The outcome was the new compilation which is based primarily on through-bills-of-lading, and therefore, in the case of some states reflects "at a part of their total foreign trade and for others includes goods produced elsewhere. The element of seasonal fluctuation, says Director Klein, should also be considered.
