1,000.00 PLAN TO ADD NEW COUNTY PRECINCTS

Dedistricting of Some Townships to be Deferred for the Present

No immediate action will be taken by the Lake county board of super-\$9,000.00 visors in redistricting the county by the Lake County board of superand Supervisor George Bairstow, chairman of the elections committee

1,200.00 which is handling the proposed plan-Waukegan and a number of other cities and towns in the county are 200.00 having the mid-decade census taken this spring. When the new figures are available, the needed changes will be made. The board is expected to hold a meeting sometime in the middle of July to re-district the county and some of the larger cities.

The report of the petty cash account of the Lake county general hospital showed \$1,229.29 on hand the first of June. The receipts and cash on hand from March 1 amounted to \$8,492.34, and the expenditures \$7,-263.05, leaving the balance afore-

There were 49 births during the months of March, April and May, the report showed. Deaths totalled 23, operations, 159; and dressings 339.

A resolution giving the Chicago, North Shore and Milwaukee railroad ...\$ 2,500.00 permission to construct a temporary overhead bridge across Highwood road for the purpose of aiding in the \$ 4,240.00 extension of the railroad from Niles Center to Rockford road was passed
