GOOD SERVICE FOR AMERICANS ABROAD

CARRY U. S. MOTOR PARTS

Tourist Bureau Advises Travel-
ers to Write to Manufactur-
ers for Information
Before Leaving

Good service facilities for a number
of American motor cars are available
in nearly every country in Europe,
according to the foreign travel divi-
sion of the Chicago Motor club tour-
ing bureau. American manufacturers
have arranged with foreign distribu-
tors to carry stocks of spare parts
and to provide efficient service. The
touring bureau advises motorists to
write to the manufacturers of their
cars before going abroad, listing the
countries they intend to visit and ask-
ing for a list of the car distributors
in these territories. It is advisable
to arrange for passage and cabin per-
mits in advance. The American
Automobile association foreign
department in New York will give ad-
vice on hotels.

In foreign countries little allowance
is made for carrying free baggage.
The baggage charge mounts up rapid-
ly when one has traveled a few hun-
dred miles, so it is advisable to take
only essential luggage. There is also
the inconvenience encountered at the
Douane, or custom house, at the bor-
der of each country when the traveler
must get-out of his car to watch his
baggage searched. If a trunk is
carried to be placed under the bed in
the cabin, make sure that it is not
more than fourteen inches high, two
feet wide, and three feet long. The
de luxe staterooms, of course, are
large enough to accommodate ward-
robe trunks, hat boxes, etc.

Tax Receipt Unnecessary
It is not necessary now to present
an income tax receipt, if you are a
citizen of the United States. All for-
eign tourists and those traveling on
anything other than an American
passport, sailing from the port of
New York, must appear personally
before the agent in charge of the in-
ternal revenue at the customs-house,
Bowling Green, New York City, re-
gardless of whatever income tax
clearance papers they have received
from the internal revenue office in the
city or town in the United States
from which they have come, and re-
ceive in exchange a sailing clearance
permit.

There are two ways to carry funds
while traveling—a letter of credit and
travelers' checks. Travelers' checks
are ready letters of credit for small
amounts, issued in \$10, \$20, \$50, \$100
and \$200 denominations. You put
your signature on them once, when
the checks are bought and again, as
identification, when you cash them.
They are accepted all over the world
as currency, and can be cashed at
banks, hotels, and large stores. They
are convenient and safe. Banks, tour
agencies and steamship lines issue
these convenient checks. A letter of
credit may also be purchased from any
of these sources. It is a certificate
that you have the amount stated on
deposit with the organization which
issues the certificate. It may be pre-
sented at any bank, or you may make
out a draft for the amount you want
to draw, payable to yourself. A mem-
orandum of your draft is made on
your letter of credit, and the money is
handed to you.

Early Application Advised
According to the American Auto-
mobile association foreign bureau it
is advisable to apply sixty to ninety
days in advance of sailing. American
citizens may enter or leave the United
States without a passport. How-
ever, they cannot enter foreign coun-
tries without one, except Canada,
Cuba, Bermuda, Mexico and the Ba-
hamas. Apply for passports to the
department of state, division of pas-
port control, Washington, D. C., the
clerk of any United States district
court or any state court authorized
to naturalize citizens. In Chicago
there is a passport agent in room 2166
Transportation building. Applica-
tions for passports must be presented
in person at the bureau, court or cus-
tom house, together with two photo-
graphs, (one signed), showing head
and shoulders front views on light
background; not more than three
inches square; printed on thin paper.
As these photographs are frequently
required during a European journey it
is advisable to have a dozen of them
made. A married woman should sign
her own given name, for example:
Mary Jane Doe, not Mrs. John Doe.
An American citizen must act as an
identifying witness. The fee is \$10.
Husband and wife may use a joint
passport.
