





PURCHASE OF USED CAR; HOW TO DO IT
 VALUABLE INFORMATION

How Dealers Fix Prices and What to Look For in Buying a Second-Hand Bus; Good Advice

Do you know what to do when buying a used car? Many motorists do not and the legal department of the Chicago Motor club outlines a few important considerations. For instance: Manufacturers set their fiscal years at various periods, so that it may happen that a 1925 car is made in 1924, but the serial number tells the year it was made. The model number means nothing. Get the engine number and inquire of the manufacturer or his agent in what year this particular number was turned out. This eliminates all possibility of buying a 1924 car for a 1925 car which is often done in cases where both buyers and seller act in good faith.

Always Check Up
 No matter how you may know the man from whom you buy a car check up through the police department to see if there are stolen cars of that number out. This is no reflection on the man from whom you buy the car; he may have obtained a stolen car without knowing the facts.

Ascertain the financial responsibility of the seller. If the seller has no financial responsibility it will be impossible to obtain adjustment in case the car does not turn out as represented. If one buys a car from a reputable dealer there is little chance that it will be a stolen car, but it is possible for the dealer to make a mistake, and if he is financial responsible he will see to it that you suffer no loss, even though the car might turn out to be a stolen one.

If the person from whom you buy the car is not a dealer, see that he is in some responsible employment. Investigate his character and general reputation so that you may not have dealings with downright crooks.

Take Precautions
 Have your car looked over by some mechanic and check up the serial numbers to see that they have not been tampered with. Do not buy a car "as is." "As is" means exactly what it says. If you buy from a dishonest person it may be tuned up to run smoothly for awhile, but after it has been run a few miles the temporary repairs will give way and you will have no recourse as you bought "as is."

Insist upon the seller making a statement in writing to the effect that the car is in good mechanical condition. Oral representations are almost impossible to prove. Get it in writing.

Do Not Be Deceived
 Above all do not let a little paint nor an honest name deceive you. The car with an excellent reputation may be in poor mechanical condition. Some purchasers deceive themselves in the belief that if the car is bought on time and that if the mechanical condition is not as represented they will withhold the payments. In most cases the financial house is a third party and is not interested in the mechanical condition of the car itself, and any defense that might be interposed as against the seller will be of no avail by the holders of the notes. Be sure to get a bill of sale which sets out the name and address of purchaser and seller, date of purchase, description of vehicle, name of manufacturer, style of engine, amount of horse power and accessories and equipment.

Copy of Bill of Sale
 The ordinary bill of sale reads as follows: Know all men by these presents, that (here insert name and address of seller) of the city of..... County of..... and State of..... party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of..... dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to (here insert name of seller) in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents, by (here insert name and address of purchaser) of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and delivered, and, by these presents, do grant bargain, sell and deliver, unto the said party of the second part, all the following goods, chattels and property, to-wit: (here follows complete description of the car) to have and to hold the said goods, chattels and property unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to and for his own proper use and behoof, forever. And the said party of the first part, does vouch himself to be the true and lawful owner of the said goods, chattels and property, and have in his full power, good right and lawful authority, to dispose of the said goods, chattels and property, and have in his full power, I do for my heirs, executors and administrators covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, to warrant and defend the said goods, chattels and property to the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns against the lawful claims and demands of all and every persons whomsoever. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal, the..... day of..... (month) in the year one thousand nine hundred..... Have the bill of sale acknowledged before a notary public.

FACTORY LIGHTING IMPROVEMENT NEEDED
 Aim of New Campaign, Nation's Electric Companies are Supporting It

The need of better factory lighting is being particularly emphasized this fall by the electric light and power companies all over the country. Stirring advertisements bearing such appeals as "Errors breed under poor light," "Poor factory lighting steals profits," "Good lighting wakes up production," are being run in many publications.

Commenting upon this great educational campaign, the current issue of the Industrial Lighting News says: "Anyone who has had occasion to visit the smaller industrial plants of the

country—that is, those plants which do not have experienced electrical engineers and a large electrical department—are well aware of the small attention that is paid to artificial lighting. Daylight when it is available, is so strong that there is usually no question regarding this subject.

"Of the darkness of late afternoon and on cloudy days, little notice is given as most persons feel that such conditions exist only a small portion of the time and the expense involved in remedying the trouble would be too great because of the short periods that artificial light would be used.


"That such thoughts are erroneous has been proven time and again, where the lighting has been changed and tests have been made. Production is greater, spoilage is less, and many other benefits are obtained. Why shouldn't this be so? On the


average, 25 per cent of the plant's working hours are spent during the darkness of late afternoon and on cloudy days."
