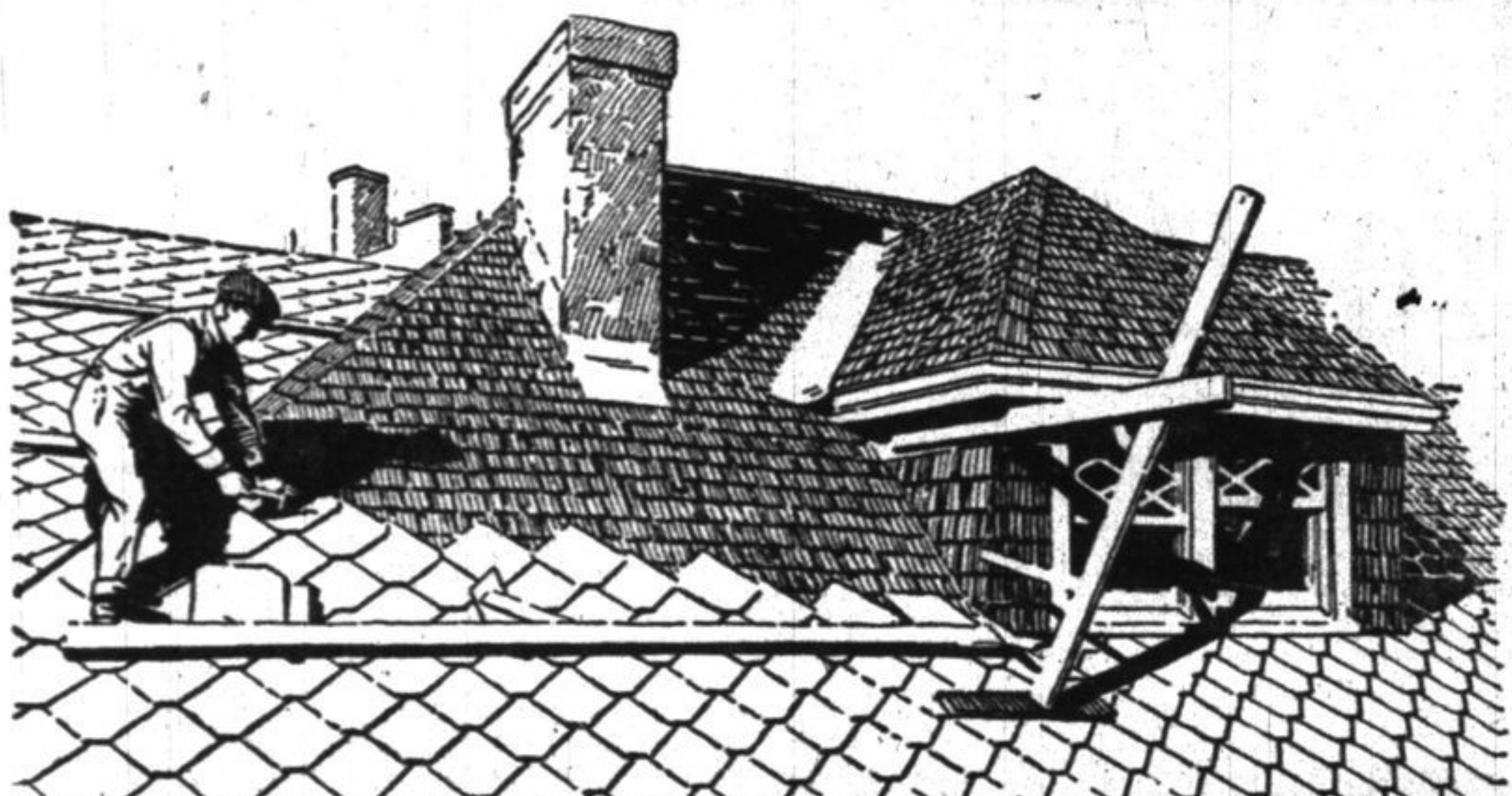

SELF-EXPRESSION CRAZE DISCUSSED

IS IT OVER-EMPHASIZED?

Dean Hardy of Northwestern in Lecture Talks About Phases of Individual Liberty; Warns of Dangers

Are Americans over-emphasizing the meaning of "individual liberty"? Is the trend of the day toward a super-abundant "expression of self" and a minimum of proper self-restraint?

In discussing "Education for Citizenship" recently from Station WMAQ, The Chicago Daily News radio, acting dean of speech, C. D. Hardy, of Northwestern university, pointed out that what our pioneer might and could do without generally harmful effect, cannot be done now. He urged educational processes both in the university and the public school to teach American youth that self-repression is quite as desirable as over-emphasis of personal liberty.

Land of Liberty
"America is a land of individual liberty," Mr. Hardy said. "We have thought that, talked it, felt it, lived by it so long, that it is just possible that we are over-emphasizing its significance. 'Express yourself,' 'Let yourself go,' 'say what you please,' 'do what you like,' 'follow the dictates of your own ambitions, and your own tastes,' 'insist upon your own individual rights'—are some of the slogans that characterize this generation. All of them are good in proper proportions. Over emphasis upon any one of them, however, is quite likely to lead to a disregard of the fundamental rights of others and of society.

Disrespect for law, cannot be commended by any right thinking citizen. Laudation of crime is not to be thought of. One need not have any special or particular law in mind, when talking to this point. Often it is alleged that present conditions are due to the war or to the aftermath of the war. It is probably more true to say that present conditions are the results of the grading complexity of our social order; and of our insistence upon doing things that were possible in a simple society that are not now possible in a more complex one. This leads to rebellion along many lines.

Must Respect Law
In other words, an emphasis upon individualism is being maintained, at certain points, where the demands of society, are insisting upon a respect for organized groups. Let it be borne in mind that citizenship, in a democracy like this cannot be maintained unless the laws laid down for the good of all receive the respect of the individual. That ought to be obvious enough, but a disregard for it has undoubtedly had a material influence in producing the present regime of a disregard for all law.

"If the law of 'express yourself' be important, the law of restraint is no less so. There are some things in a complex social order that the individual cannot do. He cannot drive his automobile just as fast as he wants to. He cannot park it where he desires. He cannot always say in public places just what he might say, if he were out on some prairie alone. He cannot show in his motion picture house all the pictures that he might desire to show, if he were the only spectator. This is old material, that's true, but it needs re-emphasis if a proper balance of social elements is to be kept. Education of the youth in schools, colleges, and universities may well have their attention drawn to the lesson on restraint that a progressive social order has always insisted upon and must in the future insist upon, if desirable progress is to continue.

Education for Citizenship
"Education for citizenship will give itself to the task furthermore of teaching youth how vital it is to do what it knows ought to be done. Social welfare and the government of society are not nearly so much a matter of knowing what to do as they are of doing what one knows he ought to do. Most any school boy can tell you plainly, on any issue, what is right and what is wrong. It is not nearly so easy to get him to follow what he knows to be right, if such actions stand in the way of certain self interests that may characterize his thinking. The government of a city, in altogether too many cases, is not a matter of knowing what ought to be done as it is a matter of doing what the dictates of right and justice insists ought to be done. Self interest, politics, ambition, the influence of certain group forces, so often get in the way of what the right action is. Here is a place where education for citizenship can add a very influential note."
