So Says Expert of State Water Survey After Analysis; Also In Other Cities

Mr. Buswell has made exhaustive ENGLISHMAN SPEAKS tests of the sewage tanks not only at Highland Park but at Decatur and Urbana-Champaign, with the result that it has been found that much valuable gas is going to waste at the present time. At Decatur alone he figures that the daily supply of gas generated by the sewage tanks has a value of \$108.
