**H. P. SEWER GAS HAS COMMERCIAL VALUE**  
 So Says Expert of State Water Survey After Analysis; Also in Other Cities

Residents of Highland Park are interested over the statement just made by A. B. Buswell of the state water survey division of the state department of registration and education to the effect that gas generated by Highland Park's sewage disposal tanks has a real commercial value and could be used for heating and illuminating purposes, having a heating value considerably higher than that prescribed by law for municipal use.

Mr. Buswell has made exhaustive tests of the sewage tanks not only at Highland Park but at Decatur and Urbana-Champaign, with the result that it has been found that much valuable gas is going to waste at the present time. At Decatur alone he figures that the daily supply of gas generated by the sewage tanks has a value of \$108.

Improvements in methods of sewage disposal are described in Mr. Buswell's report which is to be transmitted to Gov. Small as part of the program of the board of natural resources and conservation for developing water supplies and improving the streams of Illinois.

The Armory, drill ground and home of the two Waukegan national guard units, is to be rebuilt for them by the Battery C Stock company at an expenditure of \$10,000, it was learned through officers of the company.

Thieves who broke into the tailorshop of Peter Danis at 912 Lincoln street, Waukegan, last week made their escape with practically everything that was not nailed down. The loot, it is believed, will run close to \$2,000.

Robbers recently broke into a garage at Round Lake, operated by Marj tin Thelan, and stole automobile tires, tubes, spark plugs and various accessories, the whole loss being estimated at \$500.

Jacob King, aged 79, of Antioch, died last week at the County hospital. He had been ill of pneumonia for several days. Heart disease was given as the immediate cause of death.
