VIRGINIA FARMERS SEE MILD WINTER

HOW THEY BASE FORECAST

Activity of Squirrels and the Thinness of Corn Husks; Weather Bureau Says "Applesauce"

It is generally admitted that the weather up to present this year is very unusual for most parts of the country, and weather prophets over the country are now coming forward with all sorts of predictions for the winter.

In spite of the fact that Washington is the official home of the United States Weather Bureau, there are a lot of amateur prognosticators here too, many of whom front on the official weather forecasts.

Rural Prophets
Near the center of the business district in Washington is the noted Center Market where farmers from Maryland and Virginia sections come to dispose of their produce to the city consumers. Among these farmers are a number of amateur weather prophets and they are predicting that, despite the peculiar weather, this is going to be a mild winter for the United States. They base their predictions on the activities of the squirrels and the thin corn husks. One of them who is a sharp-eyed Virginia farmer voiced the general opinion to a newspaperman the other day as follows:

"Yes, I realize that nearly every one is predicting a hard winter, but that may be due to the coal strike."

"Fact is, the winter is going to be mild. I grant you that the weather man can tell when a storm is coming and he doesn't often miss, but there are certain signs which if observed will beat the weather man all hollow in telling us what kind of a winter we are going to have," said the Virginia farmer.

Squirrels Not Busy
"Squirrels and other animals I have noticed that lay in winter supplies are not very busy putting anything by this fall. I have noticed, too, in shaking corn very often that the squirrels were very busy laying in corn and nuts. Now they pass by the corn piles and stop only long enough to get one meal. I take that as a sign of a mild winter, and this sign has always proven good in past years."

"Another sign is the thin husk on the corn — very thin, and just like last year. Then, again, take the thickness of the coat on the horses. My horses have not yet begun to grow their winter coats, and their hair is almost as thin as in mid-summer."

The official Weather Bureau reply to this is "Applesauce."
