

ANNUAL MEETING COUNTY TEACHERS

Held Monday at Deerfield High School; Good Program and Large Attendance

Miss Nila B. Smith, first assistant of research in the Detroit public schools, was the principal speaker at the annual convention of the Lake County Teachers' association, which was held Monday at the Deerfield-Shields township high school auditorium.

She was followed with a shorter talk by Guy C. Caldwell, guide, naturalist and entertainer from the Rocky Mountain Park in Colorado. He spoke on "Birds, Beasts, and Wildflowers," telling of the different species of each.

To start the program off Monday morning at 9:45 o'clock an interesting musical was rendered, consisting of several instrumental and vocal numbers. Nearly 500 teachers were in attendance at the convention and according to T. Arthur Simpson, county superintendent of schools, the affair was the most successful yet held.

FLU AND PNEUMONIA RAMPANT IN COUNTY

OWEN HART, FORMER RESIDENT, IS DEAD

Passed Away Friday, Oak Park Hospital; Brief Sketch of His Life

Following three months of illness, due to pneumonia and complications, Owen D. Hart, 216 South Fifteenth avenue, died at the Oak Park hospital, Friday morning at five o'clock.

The funeral service was held from the late home Monday afternoon at two o'clock and from there to St. James' church, where the Rev. Fr. O'Shea paid a tribute to the life of the departed, having celebrated requiem high mass for him in the morning. Interment was at All Saints' cemetery.

Owen Hart was born in Grand Pass, Mo., on January 4, 1885. When he was sixteen years old he came to Chicago and worked several months at the C. & N. W. station at Highland Park. From Highland Park he went to Wyoming.

He worked for the C. & N. W. thirteen years and for the last five years had been employed by the American Telephone & Telegraph Co. in the long lines department.

He was united in marriage to Miss Mae Hofert of Highland Park in July,

eighteen years ago, and moved to Maywood with his family six years ago. He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Mae Hart, and four children, Frank, Robert, Ruth and Kay. Mrs. Hart's mother, Mrs. Sara Snyder of Highland Park makes her home with her daughter. Mr. Hart's parents reside in Harrisonville, Mo.
